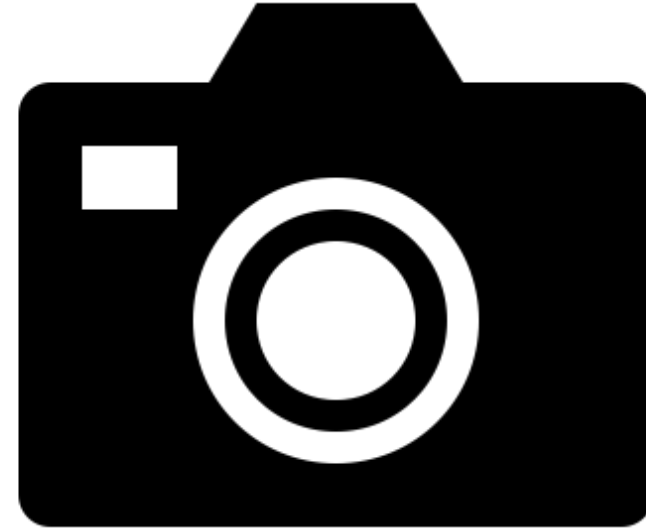
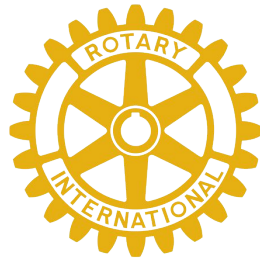

Growing local economies

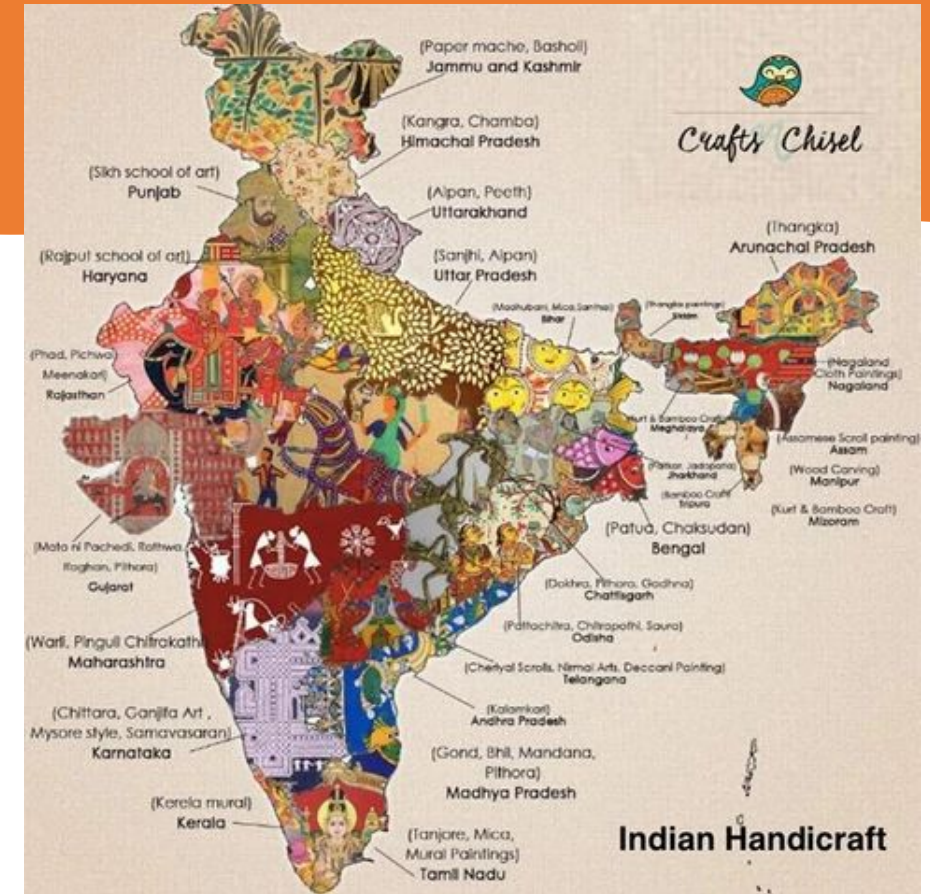
