RCCC did a joint project with IWCCC on 25th November at Mentaid Special









School, Joka, 2pm onwards.


The cricketing event was played in **85 Balls** format within the visiting team with leather balls under International Cricketing Rules.

Vote of thanks was presented by **Rtn. Binod Khaitan**


Meeting Terminated by President RR Agarwal followed by fellowship and Dinner.






