On 14th October 2022, Rotary Club of Bombay West had organised an Open Minds seminar on the theme of Cyber Frauds. It was an awareness campaign organised in association with Rotary District 3141 and Cyber Cell of Mumbai Police. The chief guest of the programme was Alpha DG Rtn. Sandip Agarwalla and Guest of Honour was Mr. Hemrajsingh Rajput, Dy. Commissioner of Mumbai Police. The programme was jointly co hosted by Rotary Club of Mumbai North Island and Rotary Club of Mumbai North End.

The meeting began with RCBW President Rtn. Dharmendra Sharma welcoming the guests and all club members for the session. The chief guest, Mr. Hemrajsingh Rajput, addressed the audience about various cyber crimes and introduced his cyber cell team of police officers. The police team of the cyber cell spoke in depth about various forms of cyber crime such as fake profile fraud, search engine edit fraud, electricity bill fraud, sextortion fraud and investment fraud.

This was followed by a panel discussion moderated by Rtn. Ravi Daswani. The speakers for the panel discussion were PDG Rtn. Shashi Sharma, Guest of honour Mr. Hemrajsingh Rajput and Rtn. Sidharth Daftary. There was a Q&A session wherein the team of Mumbai police answered all questions and doubts of the audience.

The programme witnessed a huge attendance of more than 200people attending. It was a very insightful and informative session.

Waste Management, Solar Energy & Relevant Byelaws of CHS

The Seminar on the Topic "WASTE MANAGEMENT, SOLAR ENERGY AND RELEVANT BYELAWS OF CHS" held on Sunday 2ND October 2022 at Rotary Centre, Santacruz.

The invited speakers on the Topic were (1) Shri Subhash Dalvi- Officer on Special Duty (Solid Waste Management) BMC, (2) Shri Niranjan Barve (Environment Engineer-MD, Orange Energy Solutions), (3) Smt. Ashwini Borude Waste Management Consultant, GoM, (4) Shri. Vilas Thube Manager Solar Project at L & T Infotech and (5) Rtn. Shri Hiralal Suthar, Advocate.

The speakers were par excellence in their talk/ presentations. Shri Niranjan Barve elaborated various aspects and benefits of solar projects, Mr. Vilas Thube, presented the details of systems involved and functioning of Solar Installations, Mrs. Ashwini Borude demonstrated the management of kitchen waste explaining how to use the bucket brought by her which include cultured Bacteria which generates compost to be used for growing vegetables at home, Shri Subhash Dalvi explained the scheme and the incentives offered by MCGM and also administered oath to participants about following norms for protection of environment,

and Rtn. Hiralal Suthar, advocate brought to the notice of the participants as to how the byelaws of cooperative housing societies aid, support and encourage the solar installations on common terrace of the building of society.

Rtn. Anand Gupta, Chairman RERA Housing Committee of Builders Association of India, while proposing vote of thanks informed about the projects on education of laymen on laws relating to Cooperative societies and properties laws and other relevant issues.

The programme was well received and appreciated by the participants whose numerous queries were addressed by the learned speakers resulting into extension of time of seminar by one hour from 12 p.m. to 1 p.m.

The next topic will be "Management of Housing Societies" on Sunday 6th November 2022.


