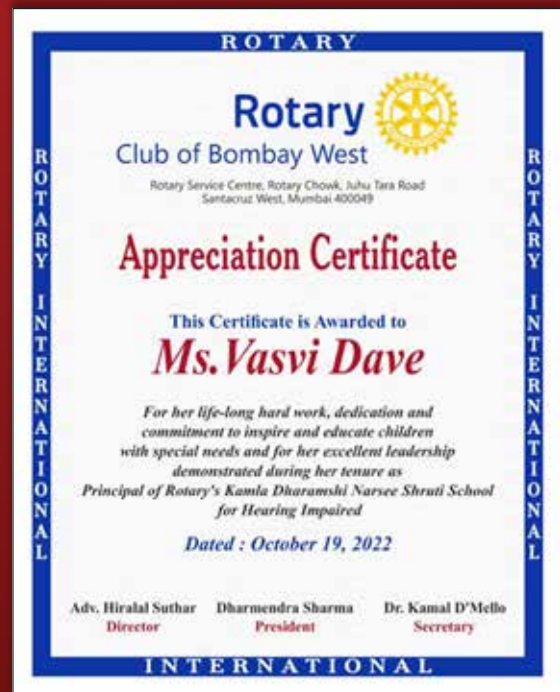
The Diwali party was compared by Kunal Jeesani he brought great energy and excitement to the evening with his jokes and games. Keeping all those present extremely well entertained.

We had started REDC with the objective to provide 24x7 service from Goregaon to Bandra but I can see that in the present scenario our services are being used over a larger geographical area.
