#### DR NARESH GUPTA ADVISES WATER FOR DISEASE FREE LIFE

**Director Professor Dr Naresh Gupta**, Maulana Azad Medical College gave the Club a deep inside into the issues concerning **Water for a Disease Free Life** during our regular meeting held on Tuesday 22 Nov 2022.

Rtn President Vandana Bhalla called the 372nd Meeting of Rotary Club of Indraprastha-Okhla to Order at 8 PM om Tuesday 22 Nov 2022. The President requested the members to raise and sing



the National Anthem. Thereafter the Four Way Test was read out by Rtn PP Prof AS Kohli.

Dr Naresh Gupta decided to introduce himself giving details of his experiences in life. He admitted that he was a health activist. He is the founder of Health Environment Foundation, an organization to promote public health aspects of environment in our society. He decided to talk to our club on Water.

In a freewheeling discussion Dr Naresh Gupta, in his talk at the Club, stressed the importance of clean drinking water. Water is need by individuals and by society as a whole. From available sources of water it needs to be determined which source is the best. Is it water from the Ganges or other rivers or from the Himalayas or from lakes or from wells. In all cases water has some contamination or the other. It is thus important that we filter our water before consumption. He disagreed with the theory that water consumed from the RO was not healthy or good for consumption. It is true that that the reverse osmosis (RO) process does remove all the impurities and also some essential salts. He explained that these are required in such small quantities by the human body that they ca be consumed by taking them as food supplements.



He was further concerned by the physical cleanliness of water. He stated that when we see what appears as clean water that we consume, we do not realise that it has hidden impurities that are harmful for the body. We take cleanliness for granted. Pure clean water when consumed will take care of half of our diseases. This is not applicable to just the poor but also the rich, who think their water has no harmful invisible impurities.

Unfortunately, India does not have adequate

potable drinking water. We need water for drinking, cooking, washing, etc. Most water we drink contains Fluoride, which is harmful to the body. The dental cream makers do promote it, but it is actually harmful. He was also concerned about the harmful effects of Lead found in our water and also Mercury in some areas. Industries causes great deal of water pollution. This pollutes our water sources directly such as rivers and ponds. Besides that, the discharge from industries gets into the soil and thus reaches us through wells, etc.

He concluded his talk by making a fervent appeal to all present to look into their drinking water sources and not just drink tap water, however much, the Jail Board may say that it is fit for human consumption!

The talk was followed by a very lively discussion amongst members.
