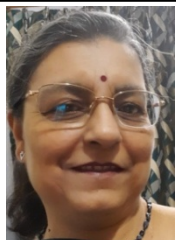
Know your District Governor 2021-2022:

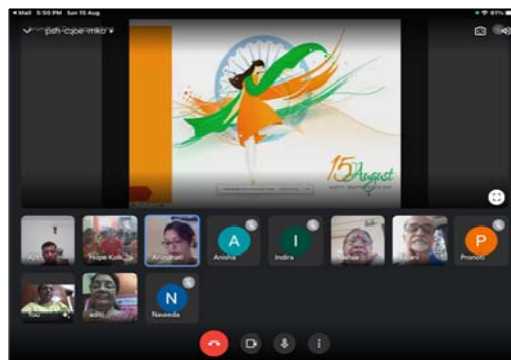

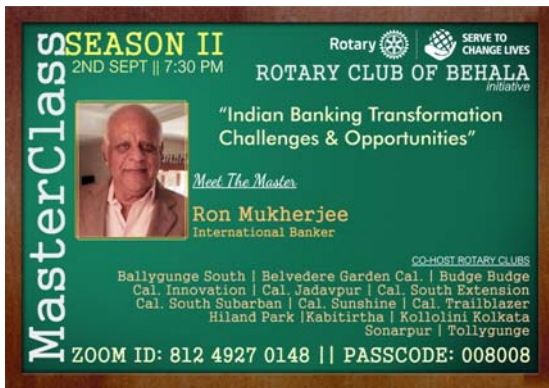
