

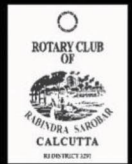
9. Saroj Sardar, Secretary, Arjun Foundation briefly talked about their initiative.

Minutes of the last meeting RWM held on the 28th Aug 2022, 11.30 A.M. at CRC.

RWM 28th Aug 2022

Venue: CRC

1. Discussed and decided to do two Literacy projects - (Teachers Day Celebration on 5th Sep and Child Education and Basic Development Project on 10th Sep) and two Community Development projects in end September and early October at Tagore Foundation and Chatuskone Park respectively.
2. Rtn Indrajit Gupta proposed if we can do a project with Dakshin Kalikata Sevasram. He also promised to make a donation. Club decided to do the project in November on the Children's Day.
3. PDG Uttam Ganguli said that he will arrange some fund for the literacy project.
4. President Kakoli Dey shared that RI dues of Rs 95, 270.84 and News Trust fees of Rs 12,840.00 has been sent.
5. President Kakoli Dey also handed over a cheque of Rs 36,816 towards District dues to Dr. Abhijit Banerjee with a request to hand it over to DG's office.
6. PDG Uttam Ganguli proposed that on the occasion of SNID on 18th September, to raise awareness to prevent Polio in areas around Rabintra Sarobar if we can do miking around with banner in auto-rickshaw as a part of mass polio immunization campaign. Rtn Sushanta Chakraborty was given the responsibility to organise the same.
