


MINUTES OF THE 2080^{TH} MEETING OF RC CALCUTTA JADAVPUR HELD AT CRC ON WEDNESDAY, 29^{TH} JUNE 2022 AT 7:00 PM

President Rtn. (Dr.) Kunal Ray called the 2080th meeting of RC Calcutta Jadavpur (RCCJ) to order. The meeting was held in Calcutta Rowing Club at Rabindra Sarobar area, Kolkata.

On the request of Dr. Ray, Rtn Paromita Das Dutta led the singing of the National Anthem.

He then requested Secretary Pausali Paul to brief the club activities taken place since last RCM. Pausali then briefed the events as noted below:

- 1) Seminar on 'Life Beyond Cancer' held on 17th June at Rotary Prakash Bhavan, Salt Lake,
- 2) Felicitation of Rtn Partha Sarkar for Pediatric Cancer Project by an NGO 'Bhavna' on 18th June, 2022,
- 3) ROTAVISION Camp at Kalitola, Hingalgunj on 19th June,
- 4) Sub-National Immunization Day (SNID) on 19th June 2022to prevent Polio,
- 5) RCC Assembly(RID 3291) held at Rotary Sadan on 19th June 2022,
- 6) Annual Interact Meet (RID 3291) held at Sarala Memorial Hall on 21st June 2022,
- 7) RCC SAMMAN Award 2022 held at RotarySadan on 24th June 2022,
- 8) Grant Management Seminar held at ICCR auditorium on 25th June, 2022,
- 9) Rotary District 3291 Award Ceremony held at Birla Sabhaghar on 26th June, 2022 and
- 10) RID Recognition for work during RY 2021-22 held at Rotary Sadan on 28th June, 2022.

All detailed reports were published in the AHANA dated 29.06.22.

Dr. Ray reported that unlike last few years, the overall level of recognition of club activities was relatively low in the District Award Ceremony while individual members' recognition was impressive. He reasoned that one of the contributing factors is likely to be the change in the categories of clubs based on the membership strength of the clubs. In RY 2021-22 RCCJ belonged to Category C (31-50 members) instead of the category for 30-40 members in previous

years. The members opined that our pleasure was derived from doing the service for the community and by that measure the club did an impressive job.

Dr. Ray mentioned that RCCJ would celebrate upcoming 'Doctor's Day' by felicitating four General Physicians from the South Kolkata area. He also informed that a medical camp would be held at RCC Canning on 3rd July 2022 and two vocational training on Bee-keeping and Mushroom Cultivation would be held there in parallel. It was decided that the toilets made recently for the students of Sondhi School at Canning would be inaugurated on that day.

He then announced that the Installation Ceremony would take place on 13th July, 2022 at Lake Club Sports Complex 1. He requested all members to be present there along with their spouses.

Club Business was conducted by Secretary, Pausali Paul. She announced the following birthdays and anniversaries of the club members and members warmly wished them for the occasion:

Anniversary of Rtn (Dr.) Subrata Chakraborty and Santwana Chakraborty (3rd July); Hony. Member Sambhu Narayan Banerjee and Krishna Banerjee (7th July); and Birthday of Rtn (Dr.) Jharna Ray (11th July).

Since it was the last RCM of RY 21-22, Club Foundation Chair Jaydeb Banerjee took the opportunity to thank President Dr. Kunal Ray and his entire team on behalf of all members for their untiring service and congratulated them for all the good work done through the year.

Minutes of 2079th meeting were confirmed.

Meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the members present. Dr. Ray then greeted Honorary Member Dr. Arup Ratan Dutta who was present to deliver a speech on 'Brain Death and Organ Donation'. Dr. Dutta explained thoroughly about the concept of Organ Donation, its criteria, and nationwide as well as statewide statistics of donation. He talked about the procedures to be followed for Organ Donation. He also mentioned the need of generating awareness among children at school level for a better result in future.

After a long and worthy interactive Q & A session, he distributed the forms to be filled for Organ Donation and assured that he would submit


the forms once filled up and given to him. IPP Dr. Aditi Nag Chaudhuri extended her vote of thanks after the speech.



Report III - Panthanibashe Pathshala



Medical camp was held successfully with around 75 beneficiaries. Special thanks to Dr. Subrata Chakraborty, Paromita and Arpita (spouse of Manas da) for doing the job so efficiently. Manasij helped immensely to keep the tally of the patients. Vocational training on Beehiving and Mushroom Cultivation were given back to back by eminent Researcher Saikat Basu (who is currently attached with Albarta University, Canada). He made the classes very vibrant with his explanations through drawings, Q/A sessions. It was very easy to understand and participants took lot of interest in starting the production process as soon as possible. Aditi di spoke about the work done by Saikat Basu in a nutshell and then a plague was gifted to him as a token of appreciation from RCCJ. To ensure NO USE OF PLASTIC, ladies of RCC started another new venture of making Cotton bags as per advice of Aditi di. They managed to make around 20 bags in just two days.
