VOCATIONAL TRAINING

On 10th July Club organised Literacy camp at RCC Arsha Vidya nidhi along with Vocational training to the underprivileged students in making of VR Battery operated cars. Exercise books and snacks were distributed to the children.

DISTRICT GRANT PROJECT

On 12th July District Grant project on LITERACY was held at Shibmandir, Mudiali where 60 underprivileged students are taught free. Club gave away 30 Plastic Tools for their study and 2 computers. IPDG Rtn Prabir Chatterjee was the Chief Guest on the occasion.



SERVICE -21-22 A ROUND UP (Secretaries Report)

July

1) On 1st July 2021 New RI year started with two projects with the presence of our DG Prabir Chatterjee.

1) At First club donated 100 kgs of Rice, 100 kgs of Atta, 15 kgs of sugar, 15 kgs of Dal, 100 tetra packs of Milk shakes, 5 kgs of Soyabean to Arunima Hospice at behala a shelter for HIV affected children in presence of DG.

2) then donated 100 kgs of Rice, 100 kgs of Atta, 15 kgs of Sugar, 15 kgs of Dal, 20 pcs of bath towels and 20 pcs of Body soaps to Shanti Nivas, Behala a home for Aged people.

2) on 17th July our Baul project was a huge success.

Total 40 Bauls were the beneficiaries.

We distributed each bag containing 1 kg of Dal, 2 packets of Tea leaves, 4 pcs of body soap, one pack each of jeera powder, dhania powder, 1/2 kg of Milk powder, Tooth paste, 1 kg of sugar, 1 pack of Turmeric, 1 pack of Coocking oil, 2 packets of Chatu and 1 each of half punjabi(Fatua).

The project started with 3 enthralling baul songs with uttam das baul in lead.. Electronic news media R Plus, Express News, and Etv Bharat covered the project.

10)Literacy Service on: 19th September *Literacy service* project was organised by RC Majestic at Arunima Hospice a home for HIV affected children. 6 students(inmates) have passed out this year and are going for Higher studies.

Club has donated Rs 25000/- to the home as first installment as Jahar Merit Scholarship to these six inmates as support to their studies which was handed over to them by PDG Uttan Ganguli.
