#### Meet our President

Mrs. Paramita Biswas is an eminent educationist and International educational consultant with UNICEF, London Montessori Centre (now Montessori St Nicholas) and similar institutions of renowned acclaim, both in India and globally.

She began her teaching career in the 1960s, teaching English Literature at Sri Shikshayatan College and Gokhale College, Kolkata. She then went on to train as a Montessorian - first gaining a Montessori teaching diploma from the Association Montessori Internationale (AMI) and then

training and working as a Montessori teacher trainer at The London Montessori Centre in UK, where she was the Academic Director for over five years. In addition, Ms Biswas also founded the Educational Support Centre in 1990, which specialises in training primary school teachers for the Government of India's TTC programme.

PCBKMV is not the first not for profit venture Ms Biswas has championed, with the most notable of these ventures being a kindergarten/primary school she set-up in rural Bengal in 1978 which currently boasts over 400 students and has grown to Class V. Uniquely, it is an English medium school in a rural village (Dasghara) of Hooghly District, West Bengal, financially self-sustaining and employing the latest training techniques including computer education.

Ms Biswas is an active member of Rotary International. She has been a member of the Calcutta Metropolitan East Club, serving as a two time President, once in 2013-14 and for a second term during 2020-21. She is also a Paul Harris Fellow.

Uniquely, besides her professional achievements, Ms Biswas was the co-lead actress of a Bengali feature film entitled "Sheemaboddho" (Company Limited), directed by the eminent film maker and honorary Academy Award winner Satyajit Ray.

# Projects undertaken by Rotary Club of Calcutta Metropolitan East – July to August 2021

1-Project: Distribution of hand sanitizers & 3 ply face masks.

**Area of Focus**- Community Service (Non-Medical) Disease Prevention & Public Image.

Our first service project for the Rotary Year 2021-2022 was held on 19<sup>th</sup> July 2021 at New Alipore Triangular Park, Ward 81. Our Club in collaboration with the Kolkata Municipal Corporation Ward 81 Councillor Smt. Jui Biswas, distributed a 100ml hand sanitizer and a 3-ply mask to a total of 215 beneficiaries. The aim of this project was to provide simple protection kits to the people keeping in mind the present Coronavirus Pandemic and the possibility of a third wave

Total project cost - ₹9,955.









#### 2 - Project: Tree Plantation Drive

**Area of Focus –** Supporting the Environment & Public Image.

Our Club in collaboration with the Kolkata Municipal Corporation Ward 81 Councillor Smt.Jui Biswas, undertook a tree planting project where 50 saplings were planted in Blocks 'F' and 'G' in New Alipore. The saplings were provided by the Kolkata Municipal Corporation. Saplings were also planted in the areas where the trees were uprooted during the Amphan Super Cyclone. The saplings are being protected by tree guards bearing our club name. The aim of this project is to restore and maintain ecological balance.

Total number of beneficiaries - 500

Total Project Cost - ₹25,000.





#### 3 - Project: Flood Relief at our RCC Amoragori Juba Sangha's old age home.

Area of Focus- Community Service (Non Medical)

Rotary Club of Calcutta Metropolitan East donated a sum of ₹15,000 towards relief for the floods caused by the overflowing Damodar river due to excessive rainfall. The entire Amta Block & surrounding villages including Amoragori were under 5-8 feet of water. In this situation, our club extended humanitarian help & support to our RCC for relief work.

Total number of beneficiaries - 50

Total project cost - ₹15,000.












#### 4- Project - Webinar on International Youth Day.

#### 5- Project - Subikash


