"Upahaar" A Gift



Project 'Sishubikash', by Rotaract Club of Ballygunge Greens under Rotary Club of Ballygunge in association with NatunerKhoje, an NGO from Nadia district initiated a project for underprivileged children at Ranipur, under Gosaba block, Sundarban, South 24 Parganas on Sunday, September 11th, 2022. As we planned over phone, I reached Pragati Police Station, formally known as Parama PS near Science City Island on EM Bypass at 8:30am and as usual police officer become my friend before we all reach & start to our project site. IPP Anjali and Spouse Ashok da have reached around 8:45am & around 9:00 am Rtn Anirban reached with full tank of fuel and we four started towards Gadkhali, 24 Parganas South which is about 100 Kms by road on the fantastic BasantiHighway Express, but under strict surveillance on speed limit 50 km/h took almost 3 hrs to reach Gadkhali ferry ghat. Team Rotaract members; Rtr.Subrota De, Rtr. Jyotirmoy Ghosh, Rtr. Suman Kumari Agarwal, Rtr. Snehasis De, Rtr. Shreyan Das Chaudhuri had reached before 10am by Sealdah Canning local train and called Anirban at least 4 times while he was on driving seat. 5 Rotaract members headed by Subrota Dey was at ferry ghat and we parked our cars in a private parking area arranged by Rotaract members. After purchase of two jambo size bag for school kits we proceed to public boat towards Gosaba ferry ghat and that took 25 minutes to reach. It was open boat without any shade or fencing and having capacity of 30-35 heads including bicycles, motorcycles and personal belongings. Young stars start to operate mobile camera to capture all





sight scenes with their fun filled moments. Our IPP Anjali di, Ashok da& Anirban also captured every moments by using their i phones.

We reached Gosaba at 12:40 pm & we hired two motor van(bhotbhoti) after having toast biscuits bought by Anirban, towards Rangabelia floatingjetty. Because of rainy day that bhotbhoti was properly covered by oval shape shade with plastic curtain in-front and back. After about 30 minutes ride we reached at Rangabelia but unfortunately one boat just left while we were paying our bhotbhoti charges and that became a big punishment for us. No local shops were open because of lunch hour. Only few biscuits were left, not even sufficient water. Around 2:10 pm a small



boat reached at beautiful well maintained floating jetty and we all captured the moment in many mobile lens together.

The young innocent captain of the boat was very cooperative and informative. He also informed us to get back to Bagbaganferry ghat before 5pm which will be the last trip to Rangabelia ferry ghat. We





now have too less time to spend at project site with kids and local villagers. Again we hired two motor van from Bagbagan ferry ghat towards Ranipur via Uttarpara which was a 40-45 minutes journey, but having two heavy sloping village concrete road that is dangerous for us. So we had to get down from those bhutbhuti motor van to avoid accident, especially for two senior citizens, our beloved Anjali di & Ashok da. We reached at project site Ranipur



villege at 3:20pm with heavy rain.

Members from NatunerKhoje had started distribution of new clothes among children and teachers when we reached at school premises. It is a private residence of a local villager. He is kind enough to provide his premises to the under privilege of the society for education.

We had very limited time so we immediately started to distribute school kits i.e. bag, 4 nos. exercise book, pencils, eraser, sharpner etc.... They also enjoyed a proper lunchbefore distribution of clothes and educational kits among 40 children.

We started for Bagbagan ferry ghat by bhutbhuti van at 4:20pm and by 4:55 pm reached safely, as we were all hungry, even many of us was completely empty stomach. We bought some biscuits & cake with hot steaming tea and finally a packet full of masalamuri for the boat ride. All 5 rotractors was so





energetic specially Subrota and they all helped and looked after IPP Anjali & Ashok da in every moments. Their timely support and cooperation in every step really touched us for a long days affairs. Unfortunately we all missed our lunch which was arranged by members of NatunerKhoje; due to limited time, we were unable to join them in their arrangements. We all felt really very bad for this situation.

This new generation have many qualities with sense of humor. We are specially thankful to all passengers and boat management for cooperating our delay of 15 minutes. From Rangabelia ghat we took two van to reach Gosaba ferry ghat for our onward boat ride to Gadkhali ghat. In between we had a lovely



soft drinks break with samosa and hot yummy rasogolla.

We safely reached at Gadkhali and enjoyed lemon tea, beforewe started our journey back to Kolkata by two cars one by IPP Anjali di and another by Rtn. Anirban. All 5 rotractors came

along with us and before we reach our city, one last tea break at a very unkown place before KLC with prajapati biscuits. My sincere regards and salute to Ashok da and Anjali di for their energy and cooperative attitude in the whole day with hectic journey at this age.

Hats off to them. Love to all young stars of Rotaract for their excellent cooperation and support for this lovely project which reminded me my old Rotary year of 2005-06. We really enjoyed a lot especially the way we successfully did this project among all little children and their innocent smile.

I also really happy to join into this project in person and brother Anirban, you are a fantastic human being who personally droped all four rotaractors to their destination at night 11pm specially for the two young girls. You are a true and committed Rotarian. I am sure that our club member late PP Amitava da(Sarker), father of Rtn.Anirban blessing his son and proud for his great work. I sincerely thanks to all RCBians, President Sanjoy and IPP Anjali di for this

areat initiatives and a very meaningful project by our club. Thinking about those little hearts and their soft innocent smiles which actually a big return "Upahaar", A million dollars gift for us and all club member those who missed this project badly. God bless us all.



Minutes of the RWM 2438 held on 08.09.22 at International club

- The President welcomed members present at RWM and requested all to rise for the national anthem.
- President informed about the upcoming projects like:-
 - 1. 5th Rota-vision camp at Munshi Prem Chand Library on 12.09.2022.
 - 2. A book donation drive "Upahaar" for the underprivileged children of Sundarbans by providing a helping hand to the NGO, 'Notuner Khoje' will be held on 11'Sep, 2022 with Rotaract Club of Ballygunge Greens, Kolkata RID-3291.
 - 3. A draft copy of MOU between RKM Narendrapur and our club was placed and read out by Rtn. Amitava in presence of President, Secretary and other members present at the meeting, which had requisite presence of members to constitute quorum. Members accepted the draft proposed MOU. Rtn Sudeep Roy has been delegated to recheck the same and give his opinion on the clauses of the draft, and whether any point needs to be rephrased. The club has decided to go ahead with the MOU in concept, and this MOU shall be valid for three years from the date of signing between the two parties, and shall be open for termination or continuation for any frame of time as mutually decided by both parties. The Mou shall not enforce any financial obligation from any party whatsoever, and all project costs shall be voluntarily settled.
