A very good gesture by our club: Guest Speaker Dr. Rupashree Dasgupta

It was a pleasant experience for me to join a meeting of Rotary Ballygunge after a long time. But beyond the feeling of fellowship, it was much more enriching with Dr. Rupashree Dasgupta as a guest speaker. Dr. Dasgupta is a famed medical practitioner who is a gynaecologist obstetrician, and specialises on cancers of the ovary, uterus and the cervix, and is currently practicing at the Apollo Multispecialty Hospital at Kolkata.

She spoke elaborately on the signs that the body gives at the onset of problems, and what to look out for, for prevention and early intervention of problems related to the reproductive organs. Her talk covered topics like menstruation cycles, pause in menstruation, types of ovarian cancer, types of tumours at the uterus, and cervical cancer too. She used graphic representation through power point slide show to make complex understanding easier.

After her talks, she has taken question and answers session and also met with questions on a one to one basis. It was an informative session especially for the men who attended the meeting, as it is more important for the men to become aware of women health issues, as they are usually the deciding force in a family in the social fabric of India.

Dr. Rupashree Dasgupta is due for special thanks as she offered her free services to Rotary Ballygunge organised health camps and awareness programmes, as and when required.

Project 3	Disease Prevention and Treatment (Project towards Eye care and Avoidable Blindness)	RCB members conducted the RotaVision Project at the Santoshpur village, with the help of the local Panchayat Members and the Vision Rx employees. This RCB Project had Three Opthalmologists and also another three volunteers. All six people came from Vision Rx. Total Testing Done: 185 villagers Vision Problems Detected: 132 beneficiaries Achievement Percentage: 71%
Project 4	Disease Prevention and Treatment (Project included "Know Your Numbers" camp)	Health Camp: 200 beneficiaries benefited from the 5 Doctors, along with free distribution of medicine, Free check up of basic parameters for all through Know your numbers and Free ECG for all having suspected cardiac problems. Members of the Rotary Club of Ballygunge were actively involved in the above mentioned Mega Health Camp, and the same was highly appreciated by the villagers of Santoshpur and also people from all neighbouring villages.
Project 5	Supporting the Environment	Tree Plantation: 10 Saplings were planted. The dream of having ten huge fruit trees started with this.

One waiting and sitting area has been allotted for systematic procedures and after every individual cheak up we have provided one bottle of water, one food packet for every beneficiaries and one school pouch with 2pen, 2 pencil, sharper, eraser and one scale for every students.
