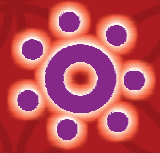

In attendance was Project Chairman IPP Rtn Subhashis Ghosh along with Co chair Rtn Chandra Kr Paul and President RCCNE Rtn Ramprasad Chattopadhyay.

Minutes of the 1565th Meeting of Rotary Club of Calcutta North East held at The Antelope, 3, Ho Chi Minh Sarani, Kolkata - 700071 on 03.11.22 at 8.00 PM.

- ❖ President Rtn Ramprasad Chattopadhyay called the meeting to order followed by national anthem.
- ❖ President announced that the venue for DG Visit has been decided at Rotary Club of East Calcutta. He had visited the same with PP Rtn Srikanta Basu Mallik and PP Rtn Kamal Pal, and they were satisfied with the renovation. He also informed that Mr. Surendranath Majumdar will be inducted as a member of RCCNE on that day.
- ❖ President announced that the next health check-up camp (Project Ujjivan) will be set up on 6th November 2022, Sunday at Medilite Clinic.
- ❖ President informed the members that the appeal for EIRWT Grant will be submitted soon.
- ❖ President spoke about the Polio Rally which was held on 23rd October 2022, and was attended by PP Rtn Prabir Kumar Paul, PP Rtn Chandra Kumar Paul, and President himself. He also mentioned that another project was done on the same day at Universal Smile, where students and helpers were provided lunch, sponsored by Rtn Prabir Kumar Paul, who attended the project along with President.
- ❖ President informed the members that two members will be attending Oikatan, Multi District RCC Conference, representation from RCCNE.
- ❖ Secretarial business was conducted.
- ❖ President announced that the date for MAA Project, has been fixed on 15 January 2023. He then requested the Chairman of MAA Project, PP Rtn Chandra Kumar Paul, to preside over the meeting. PP Rtn Chandra Kumar Paul greeted the members, announced the date and the venue, Hrishikesh Park, and said that kits will be provided to 500 beneficiaries. He also said that within the next one month, kits will be provided to 200 more beneficiaries outside of Kolkata, to be discussed later. So the total number of beneficiaries for this year will $500 + 200 = 700$.
- ❖ He further said that the invitation card has been finalized and emails will be sent to all District Officials and other dignitaries as soon as possible. Chairman expressed his desire to book a table at the District Conference (to be held on 6th, 7th and 8th January, 2023) to promote Project MAA.
- ❖ Chairman informed that this year, a few committees will be formed to look into the various aspects:
Fundraising : Rtn Salil Kumar Chandra and Rtn Suven Mukherjee.
Accounting: President Rtn Ramprasad Chattopadhyay.

Form distribution: Chairman and Rtn Sabyasachi Roy.

Purchase of materials: PP Rtn Saumendra Mohan Rakshit, Rtn Angana Paul and Mrs. Sohini Roy.

Packing in-charge & logistics: Rtn Swapnamita Roy.

❖ It was decided that President and PP Rtn Sudip Kumar Dutta will look into the technicalities and matters arising with 80G.

❖ Chairman requested all the members to raise funds and PR for the MAA Project.

❖ With no further agenda, President terminated the meeting.
