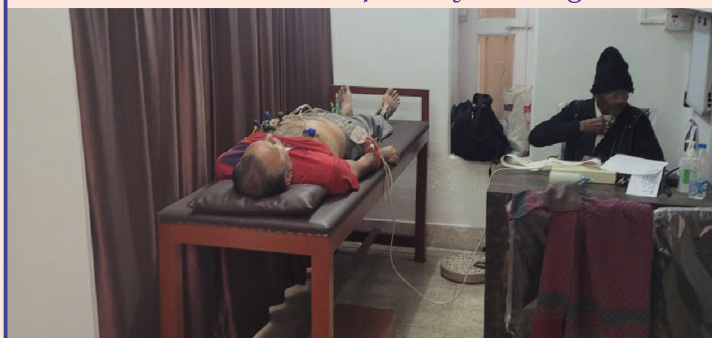

This year 600 beneficiaries were provided Kits containing Sarees, Blanket, Durrie, mosquito net, Umbrella, Slippers, Hygiene Kit, Biscuit Packets, Dry Food and Lunch Box.

The Project started at 10:30 AM followed by National Anthem and Lighting of the Lamp by Project Icon Smt Suchitra Ghosh, President Ramprasad Chattopadhyay and Project Chair PP Rtn Chandra Kumar Paul.
