❖ Finally President terminated the meeting with no other agenda left and invited all the members including Rtn Ramraj to join for fellowship.

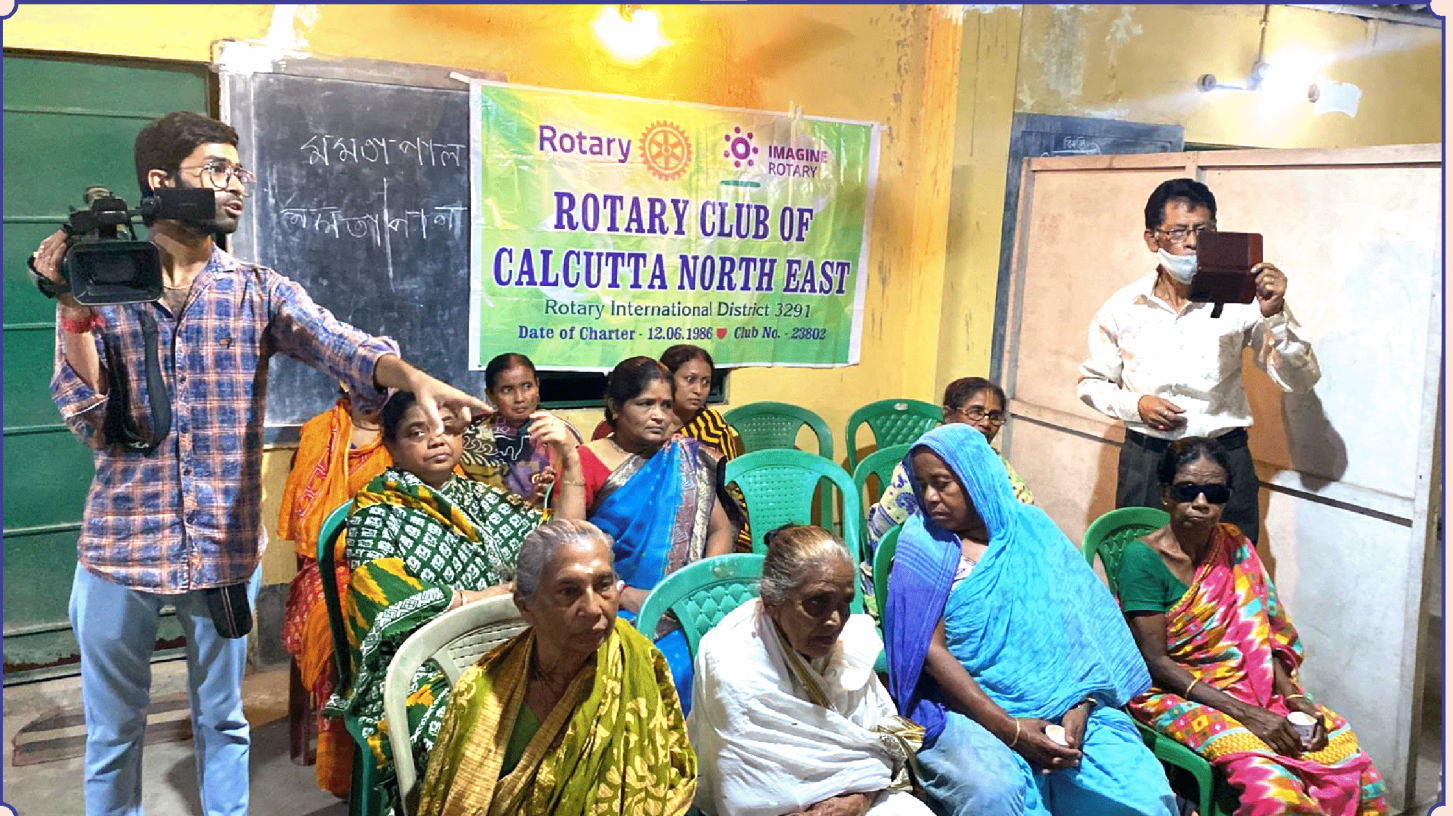
