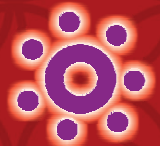

Rotary District 3291 in collaboration with R N Tagore Hospitals - Narayana Health is going to celebrate World Spine Day on 16th October, 2022 (Sunday). The celebration will consist of an Awareness program on Back Pain and Neck Pain along with Spinal disorder. There will be discussion on prevention and treatment of back pain and neck pain, which are increasing exponentially these days among all age groups. R. N. Tagore Hospitals is going to launch a dedicated SPINE CLINIC for patients with spinal disorder, back pain and neck pain on that day. The clinic will be run by a spine surgeon, physiatrist (doctor who does non-operative treatment for spine problems) and a pain management specialist. R. N. Tagore Hospital has decided that it will provide a privilege card for the members of the co-host clubs. With this privilege card, the members who have attended the program can avail the investigations ordered at Spine Clinic at a subsidized cost. Moreover, there will be a zero waiting period for appointment and consultation for the card holders.
