Several welfare projects were executed in the last Rotary year under the able leadership of IPP Supriti Banerjee, few of which are listed below:

1. **Our club funded the deep tube well project** and community toilet for women at tribal village Dhaska in water starved district of Purulia. Villagers, especially women and children were immensely benefited.



2. **Blood donation camp** was organised by our Interact Club Madhyamgram Nabojobon school on 18 August. MP Sri Saugoto Roy was present.
3. **Women empowerment program - Ananya** through a Seminar "Rotary Day of Service for Empowering Girls (স্বপ্ন)" was organized along with 75th Independence Day celebration on 15/08/2022.



4. **Virangana** Programme for Training of 30 women on Self-Defence was organized jointly with RC Majestic at our Kasba Sporting Club venue on 23rd and 24th of October. The Virangana Programme also included Consultation by Nutritionist and Psychiatric Counsellor.



5. **Plantation** of 25 mango & 10 lichi saplings was arranged to at Jagatipota near Mukundapur, Kolkata East on 29 August 2021.

6. **Oxygen Generators and Oxygen Cylinders** were donated to ESI Hospital, Maniktala, for treatment of Covid Victims. O₂ generator & cylinders were procured with support from United Way, Bengaluru.



7. **Awareness program** organised by RC North Calcutta on 22/08 at Kaijuri RCC was addressed by PP Bandana & PP Ramendu Hom Chaudhuri. Issues like Menstrual Hygiene, Mother and Childcare was discussed.

8. **Thalassemia awareness camp** was held at Baruipur on 8 September. More than 100 people participated at the Menstrual hygiene awareness camps.

9. **Women health check-up camp** held at Kautal where 100 BMD tests, 60 HPLC tests were conducted by our medical team headed by PP Dr R Hom Chaudhury.

10. **Mega Blood donation camp** was organised at Kasba Sporting on 19/09 along with health check up facility. Several members donated blood.

11. **Dress and Sweets** were distributed to over 50 children on 8/10/21 at the Durga Puja Pandal of Palli Sangha Club, Kasba. The Local Councillor Mr. Bijon Lal Mukherjee graced the occasion.



12. **Eye check-up camp** was organised at Premananda Boys School, Bibirhat on December 12, 2021 under the District **Rotavision Project**. Eye check-up of sixty five students & teachers were done and Spectacles were also given to them.

13. **Fourteen toilets** were built by our club in RCC Taldi in the last Rotary year with matching grant from the district. Several members visited our Rural RCC on Dec 12 to inspect the toilets built by us, which were found in working condition.



14. Dist. 3291 initiated **Mega Thalassemia Awareness Programme** was organized in collaboration with Dist 3240, 3250, 3262 & 3281 at ICCR on 5th February 2022. The program was attended and addressed by Respected Mayor Janab Bobby Hakim and Rotary International President Rtn Sekhar Mehta.

16. Our club funded **excavation of a 150' x 100' x 15 ft deep pond** at tribal village Daksha in Purulia. It will help to improve agriculture and fishiculture in the tribal village. Sustained work continues to provide clean drinking water, health, medicine, and education to habitants of Dhaska.
