PROJECTS & ACTIVITIES

01.09.21 - Education & Literacy / Livelihood Generation : Against the appeal for financial support to Ms. Angelica Florian (received from Rtr. Siddhant, President, Rotaract Club of Calcutta Yuvis), Rtn. Sunil Ganerwal of our Club has been kind enough to employ Ms. Florian in his Office so that she can fulfill her aspiration for completing her B. Com. from St Xaviers College (Evening) and also support her family. She is in her 3rd year now and was facing difficulty in paying her 5th sem fees.

03.09.21 - Membership Development : Mr Saurav Jain was inducted as a member of the Club. Saurav holds a MBA degree. Having Specialised in Investment Advisory, he works as the State Head at M/s. Purnartha Investment Advisory. He is married to Manisha Bihani and the couple are blessed with a son, 'Devansh' aged 4 years.

04.09.21 - Disease Prevention & Treatment : A Blood Donation Camp was organized at Bhangar on the occasion of Rotary Service Day with the support of Jibanpur Human Development Society and Narayana Howrah Blood Bank. A total of 33 units of Blood were collected at the camp inspite of 7 donors being rejected due to recent Covid Vaccination, High BP or Sugar. President Naveen, Rtn Pawan & Rtn Arvind attended the Camp along with Utsav Gopalka, son of Rtn Arvind.

05.09.21 – Environment Protection : Project 'Hariyal' – Around 5000 Tree saplings were distributed (4500 – Fruit Saplings; 250 – Shegun Tree Saplings; & 250 – Mahogany) at Uttar Rajyadharpur Village near Baidyabati, Hooghly to over 350 villagers (mostly farmers). A few saplings were also planted by the Rotarians present and the visiting associates from Aditya Birla Janseva Trust (ABJST) & Ganga Mission

The programme was attended by DGN Rtn Hiralal Yadav, Shri Prahalad Goenka of Ganga Mission, Visiting Rtn. Kazi Ashma Azmer from Bangladeshi and representatives of ABJST from Jayashree Insulators

It was also attended by Past Presidents Pankaj, Vidhu, Ashish and also Rtns Pawan, Bikash & Manoj Agarwala

16.08.21 – Environment Protection 'E-waste Management' : A seminar on e-waste collection & disposal was organized at our Regular Weekly Meeting at The Compass Conference Hall in association with Hulladek Recycling Pvt Ltd, an organization which assists the e-waste producing businesses to reduce the toxic impact by collecting, segregating, transporting & recycling

their e-waste. Ms. Apeksha Sharma and Ms. Arati Sharma gave a presentation on e-waste and the work Hulladek is doing. They also discussed how the Club can help them in their goals of reducing the National Carbon Footprints.

Apart from the members the seminar was also attended by Annes Anju Pasari & Sarika Agarwal.

19.09.21 - Education & Literacy : Inauguration of renovated School Building of “Abul Kalam Azad Academy” : “Abul Kalam Azad Academy” at Nalmuri, Narayanpur, Bhangar, South 24 Parganas, West Bengal is being run by Jibonpur Human Development Society. This WB Board of Primary Education registered school, which is in operation since 2010 was running till class IV (Nursery, Lower Nursery, Upper Nursery, I, II, III, IV) with a total of about 110 students in the academic years, prior to the pandemic. Before the current renovation, it had about 800 square feet of constructed area with a G+1 structure. Additional floor area of about 1600 square feet has been added by us through construction of a new G+1 structure. The addition of the new building is done in such a fashion that the whole school Building looks one composite unit. Apart from this, the existing building was also upgraded and renovated. Based on the newly added 4 classrooms, the school has applied for extension till class VIII and expects to get the approval soon.

This school which is on a land area of approximately 6 Katha, also has a guarded play ground. The Club added 5 toilets and a proper covered wash area to the school premises. We also added another staircase for safety (which was a must for NOC from Fire department) and provided Marble flooring of the school

The renovation activity has been done with the financial support of the the CSR team of RSH Global Pvt.Ltd, who were kind enough to sanction Rs 20.40 Lakhs for the project in December 2020. Despite the pandemic, we could complete the project in less than 12 months time thanks to the active supervision of Rtns. Manoj Pasari, Harish Sekhsaria & Manoj Lily Agarwal. The active supervision also resulted in substantial cost savings. As against the original proposal and sanction of Rs. 20.40 Lakhs, the actual total expenses on the project was Rs. 19.30 Lakhs

The school which is already considered as the best performing primary school of the area is expecting to soon rise to a total student strength of about 300 students every academic year.

19.09.21 - Women & Child Care (Safety & Security)

'Virangana' : A 3 day Self defense training camp for Girls was organized at the newly constructed site of Abul Kalam Azad Academy at Bhangar wherein around 50 girls were trained in "AIKIDO", a modern Japanese Martial Art, under Internationally acclaimed trainer Sensei Avijit Mitra, (who is also instrumental in Calcutta Police Project- 'Tejaswini') and his team, Sensei Utpal Chakraborty and Sensei Deeptanil Roy.

This was one of the various Women self-defense Workshops being organised under the initiative of Rotary International District 3291.

19.09.21 - Training & Employment Generation : The 2nd Batch of Beautician course at Bhangur got completed . Certificates were distributed to the successful trainees and were assured of support for employment and/or further training.

The 3rd Batch of Beautician Course was also inaugurated with 20 ladies who are expected to receive training for the next three months, twice a week, at a nominal cost of Rs 200/- including the cost of consumables.

26.09.21 - Disease Prevention & Treatment 'Polio SNID'

: The District 3291, Polio Plus team offered us to host & manage the Sub National Immunization Day (SNID) Polio round for 26th September at Ward-8: Borough-1 Raja Raj Ballav St, Sovabazar, Baghbazar, Kolkata- 700003. SNID is a house to house activity wherein the teams visit the houses in the vulnerable/ high risk areas to administer Polio drops to the 0-5 year old. The Club managed the Campaign / Announcements in the locality to create awareness on the need of Polio Vaccination and the SNID. This program was followed by the felicitation of the local Polio Immunisation Team and the local Councilor.

29.09.21 - Disease Prevention & Treatment 'Defeat Diabetes'

: On the Rotary day of Service to Defeat Diabetes (an initiative of Rotary India & RSSDI to Test, Track & Treat under 'One Nation, One Day, One Million Blood Sugar Tests'), the Club organized free Blood Sugar Check-up Camps at Rishra & Hindmotor in association with M/s Chikitsa Medical Centre. In spite of heavy rains and water logging, around 100 people were checked in each of the centers.

PROPOSED/ PLANNED PROJECTS -

- ★ **Water Purifier Distribution** : Rtn. Sarad Kumar Khatore proposed about distribution of water purifier through our Rotary Community Corps (RCC), Human Development Centre, Joynagar at Sunderban area. He further reported that one Charitable organization named Sri Baba Ganga Ram Seva Samity has also shown interest in this project. The club proposes to undertake the project under a helping grant of 100 water purifiers (@945/- per water filter). A committee has been formed for this project. Rtn. Sunil Ganeriwala, Rtn. Sarad Kumar Khatore, Rtn. Jitendra Kumar Goyal & Rtn. Naveen Agarwal will act as the Member of this committee.
- ★ **Drinking Water Kiosks** : The Club plans to install six drinking water dispensing unit in and around Barasat and Bantala Areas with financial support from M/s Rampyari Devi Soni Charitable Trust (CSR partner of M/S RAMA Overseas Ltd.). Rtn Sunil with the help of PP Rtn. Sarad Khatore to lead the project.
- ★ **Tree Plantation** : Rtn. Harish Seksaria Proposed a project to plant fruit sapling at Sunderban along with Rotary Club Urbana in 50:50 ratio of financial liability. Further discussions are in process.
- ★ **Vision Centre** : Rtn. Manoj Agarwala (Srirampur) is continuing a discussion with the Aditya Birla Jan Seva Trust for starting a Vision Centre in Rishra where Eye Care will be undertaken on a regular basis and economically weaker persons needing Cataract (IOL) Surgery will be referred to the Rotary Hooghly Eye Hospital for free/ subsidized Operation.
- ★ **Eco-achievers Quiz** : The Club along with Saevus will be launching the 21-22 edition of the immensely successful and first of its kind online Family Eco Achievers Quiz in October. Prelims will be from October 24th to January end, every Sunday morning at 11 am. Format will be same as last year. Participation fee will be same as last year ie INR 50 per family.

RUNNING PROJECTS

Green Leaf School : The Renovation work at the Green Leaf School is expected to be completed in October 2021.

Beautician Course : The 3rd Batch of The Beautician course at Abul Kalam School, Bhangar has been inaugurated on 19.09.21 with 20 ladies attending the same.

Beautician Course : The first Batch of Beautician Course at Serampore, Hooghly has re-commenced after a Covid Break and is due to be completed shortly.

Suchita : Toilets Projects in Chakdah & Birlapur - The construction of 17 Toilets at Birlapur was approved on 29th August 2021 and the work is expected to start shortly.

Old Age Home Monthly Rations : (Join Project with Rotary Serampore) – The Club has decided to contribute Rs. 3,000/- per month for Rations to the Matri Sadan, an Old Age Home at Konnagar, Hooghly. Rotary Serampore to contribute the balance Rs. 3000/- needed per month.

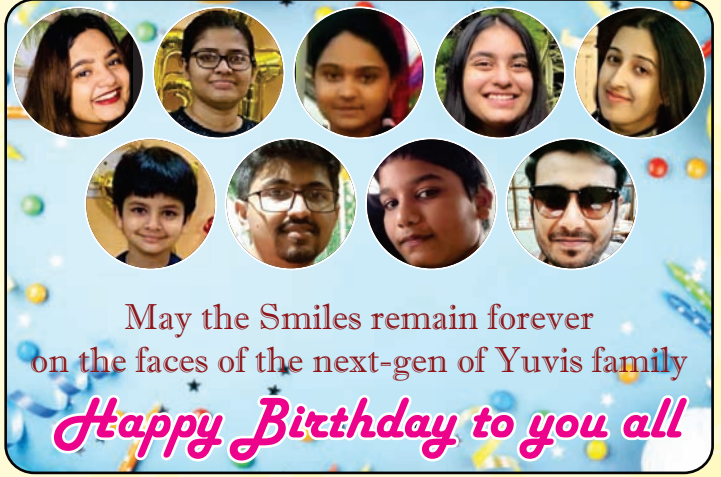
