13th August - Disaster Management - Residents of the flood affected areas of Gobindapur Abadh, Patharpratima Island Block (G) at Sundarbans were provided 120 Tarpaulin. The project was undertaken by our Rotaractors with the help of one NGO Shareerspeak. The Cost of the project was Rs. 40,000/- being fully financed by the Rotarians.

15th August - Independence Day Celebration - The members joined the RCC, Jibonpur Human Development Society and over 150 local people at Bhangor, Kolkata in celebrating the 75th Independence Day by hoisting the National Flag and paying respect to the Freedom Fighters. Members present were JKG, MP, VC, MLA, DK, HS, AA.

15th August : Environment Protection 'Hariyali' - The club members undertook plantation of 500 fruit bearing saplings at Chakda, almost 100 kms from Central Kolkata.

These saplings have been provided to the beneficiaries who were supported by us in their toilet construction earlier.

It was a day of real hands-on project.... a day when we got to know that we need to put salt in the hole before putting in the Nariyal saplings... a day when an almost 60 yrs old worked in the field.

The members could visit 68 houses and could plant more than 200 saplings on our own and ensured that all the 500 saplings have reached to the genuine beneficiaries.

Special thanks to Mr. Ranjit Biswas, a 70 yrs old local contact of ours who played a very important role.

The silver lining was that it also acted as a survey of our earlier efforts in providing Toilets to the Villagers and it was heartening to find that all the 68 toilets built under 'Suchita' were getting used, a perfect example of a sustainable project.

15th August : Support in Vocation & Women empowerment 'Saundarya' - Certificates were handed over to the 40 female graduates of the completed 1st & 2nd batches of the Beautician Course. The 3rd Batch to start from 19th Sept. 2021.

15th August : Support in Vocation & Women empowerment "Sui-dhaga' - A new Vocational Training Centre for Stitching Training was inaugurated at the Abul Kalam Azad Academy, Bhangor.

15th August : Health & Hygiene - A Menstrual Hygiene awareness programme was organized at Bhangar with over 70 female participants. The participants were also provided with a Hygiene Kits costing Rs 160/- each. The club also distributed 200 Masks to the local people present over there "Free of Cost".

15th August : Environment Protection 'Hariyali' - The Plantation & distribution of 400 fruit bearing saplings was done at Bhangor.

15th August : Health & Hygiene - An Orthopedic Health Checkup camp was organized at Hindmotor in association with Chikitsa Diagnostic Centre. In this orthopedic camp we provided free doctor consultation, BMD Test, Physiotherapist consultation and medicine. There were 93 beneficiaries, and the patients paid a nominal Rs. 50 as registration. 20th August : District Project 'Hariyali' - Rtn. Harish Seksaria, Rtn. Ashish Agarwal, Rtn. Naveen Agarwal & Rtn. Pawan Jain attended the Districts Projects "Hariyali". Rtn. Pawan Jain had arranged 3000 Saplings for this Project. The Rotary Int District 3291 has distributed 20,000 Saplings, and on this day 300 Saplings at EM Bypass were planted on behalf of the Yuvis. Program was attended by eminent singer Mr. Surajit and many officials of KMDA.

29th August : Health & Hygiene 'Suchita' - Toilet Construction - A team of Rotarians visited Birlapur where they undertook inspection of 25 new sites and handed over 13 newly constructed toilets to the beneficiaries. They rejected 8 applications for toilets, primarily on beneficiaries' economic grounds. Attended by Rtns SKK, SP&AG

29th August : Health & Hygiene ' Blood Donation' - The Club supported a Blood Donation Camp at Rishra along with Sova Jeev Kalyan Trust & Marwari Yuva Manch. 35 Units of Blood were collected at the Camp. Blood Sugar, Blood Group, Blood Pressure & Hemoglobin were also checked In this camp free of charge.



PROPOSED/ PLANNED PROJECTS -

- Domestic Water Purifier Distribution Rtn. Sarad Kumar Khatore proposed about distribution of water purifier through our Rotary Community Corps (RCC), Human Development Centre, Joynagar at Sunderban area. He further reported that one Charitable organization named Sri Baba Ganga Ram Seva Samity has also shown interest in this project. The club proposes to undertake the project under a helping grant of 100 water purifiers (@945/-per water filter). A committee has been formed for this project. Rtn. Sunil Ganeriwal, Rtn. Sarad Kumar Khatore, Rtn. Jitendra Kumar Goyal & Rtn. Naveen Agarwal will act as the Member of this committee.
- Drinking Water Kiosks The Club plans to install six drinking water dispensing unit in and around Barasat and Bantala Areas with financial support from M/s Rampyari Devi Soni Charitable Trust (CSR partner of M/S RAMA Overseas Ltd.). Rtn Sunil with the help of PP Rtn. Sarad Khatore to lead the project.
- Tree Plantation Rtn. Harish Seksaria Proposed a project to plant fruit sapling at Sunderban along with Rotary Club Urbana in 50:50 ratio of financial liability. Further discussions are in process.
- Vision Centre Rtn. Manoj Agarwala (Srirampur) is continuing a discussion with the Aditya Birla Jan Seva Trust for starting a Vision Centre in Rishra where Eye Care will be undertaken on a regular basis and economically weaker persons needing Cataract (IOL) Surgery will be referred to the Rotary Hooghly Eye Hospital for free/ subsidized Operation.
- Eco-achievers Quiz The Club along with Saevus will be launching the 21-22 edition of the immensely successful and first of its kind online Family Eco Achievers Quiz in October. Prelims will be from October 24th to January end, every Sunday morning at 11 am. Format will be same as last year.

Participation fee will be same as last year ie INR 50 per family.

Running Projects -

Saundarya - The 2nd Batch of The Beautician course at Abul Kalam School, Bhangar has re-commenced after a Covid Break and is expected to be completed by August end and the 3rd Batch is expected to start from 19th September 2021

The Beautician Course at Serampore, Hooghly is also expected to re-commence in early September 2021

Sui-dhaga - A new Sewing training Centre has been started at Abul Kalam School, Bhangar

In the coming week, the Club organised a Club Officials Training Seminar, Profectus on the 21st and 22nd of August, 2021 along with a few other clubs, in which they hosted 12 sessions with a lot of eminent faces in the Movement. On 22nd the Club Members also visited Bally Police Stationtp celebrate Raksha Bandhan with them and felicite them for the services they provide to us and the society. The project turns to be a flagship event of ours naming, Suraksha Bandhan.

The Club egarly participated in the initiative Hariyali wherein they went ahead and planted 50 saplings, under the banner of Rotary Club of Calcutta Yuvis, Rotaract and Rotary District 3291.
