Minutes of the RWM 2659 & DG Visit Club Assembly of Rotary Dum Dum, held on 20.08.2022 at Club Premises at 07.00 pm.

President Rtn Soumen Deb called the **meeting to order** and welcomed all the members, AG Rtn Meena Ghosh, Dist Secretary-OCV Rtn Amitava Chakraborty, Guest Dr Dhananjay Ghosh, Mrs Mita Ghosh and Kothari Family, RCC representativet Mondal Sri Santos Mondal to the RWM 2659. DG Rtn Ajoy Kumar Law & First Lady Mrs Mitali Law joined at a little later stage and were welcomed by President and Chandrima Deb.

President requested Rtn Dr Asitava Sur to lead the National Anthem.

President request club secretary to proceed with the Club Business.

Club Business:

Club Secretary PP Rtn Swarnendu Saha informed:

He enlightened upon following:



Rotary Dum needs to **induct members from younger generations,** since it is a 56 year old club and it has to go to 100 years so new and younger leadership has to take the mantle. With the digital age in Rotary also, younger generations are required upload the activities in Rotary websites and social media for better Public Image. He said that due to Covid, many older members we lost since there was no physicall meeting and fellowship. Older people were not very comfortable in online interaction and lost interest in Rotary.

On Membership- he said IPRIP Rtn Sekhar Mehta had given a call " **Each one bring One**" and as a result this 1st July , in our Dist membership figure is up by 200+ numbers and by end of July22 another 100 odds have been added. He requested **each member present** to make some effort to **bring atleast one new member**.

On Signature Project- DG said that Rotary Dum Dum is famous for its signature Project SCAW. Since presently it is not there for couple of years, Rotary Dum Dum should plan for a signature project to be executed in next couple of years.



On Foundation- DG stated that **donations from Rotary Dum Dum in Foundation** has been poor in recent past. It needs improvement. Average of USD 100 per year per member should be maintained. More amount is donated, more will come back on the third year accordingly. He encouraged members to come forward and donate.





On **District Projects**, He announced the following:

- a. Rotavision to continue this year as well with VRX.
- b. **Mosquito nets and Blankets** will be available at 50 per cent cost being bourne by Dist. In very short time, 50 Mosquito nets will be offered to each club and Blankets in November.
- c. Awareness camps on Cervical cancer to continue.
- d. **Awareness camps on Thalasamia** -- Interact Schools may be encouraged.
- e. Free Vaccination camps are in Pipeline.
- f. Distribution of **Saplings for plantation** ius expected shorty.


Interaction with members
