Rtn Runjhun Gupta was inducted as new member of the Club by the DG Rtn Prabir Chatterjee on 6.7.2021.



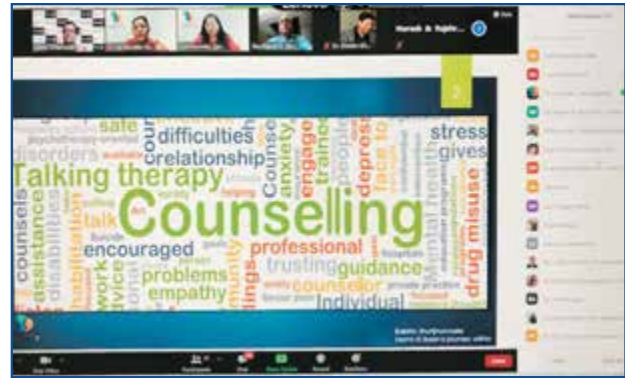
WORKSHOP ON MENTAL WELLNESS-MAAN KI BAAT-A JOURNEY WITHIN

VISIT OF DELEGATIONS FROM SINGAPORE ON 8.3.2022

We have visiting Rotarians from Singapore, particularly from our sister club i.e. Rotary Club of Singapore-RID-3310 to see Oxygen Plant at Ispat Cooperative Hospital, Kalikapur. The delegation comprised of DG Rtn Dolly Yeap, DRFC Rtn Dr Shahul Hameed, Rtn. Mrs Hameed, Rtn Peter Brock- Community Service Director of RC of Singapore and Mrs Tanya Brock. They visited Ispat Cooperative Hospital on 8.3.2022 and after the brief introduction by the Hospital and the visiting team, we visited the Oxygen Plant site.

The visiting team was highly impressed with the setting of the Oxygen Plant and made various queries. They also visited the cabin where Ventilator was placed and also Dialysis department, which according to them, is the best in the surrounding area. Even though the oxygen crisis may be over, but the plant of INR 30L + will still save them about INR 30L in 2 to 3 years, and that is net saving of 10 to 15 Lacs per year. Funds which can be used to impart affordable health care to the surroundings.



WORKSHOP ON "OUR PLATE & THE PLANET" BY RTN AMBAREE MAJUMDER

Our Plate & The Planet, this was the subject Rtn Ambaree Majumder, our Guest speaker of the day, chose to speak about on 12th March, 2022.

She mentioned that we all knew protection of the environment of our planet is one of the most talked about subjects today and the concern is only growing. Through her deliberations Ms. Ambaree made it abundantly clear that "WHAT WE PUT ON OUR PLATE (FOOD) HAS A MAJOR IMPACT ON THE ENVIRONMENT". Just as different foods have differing impacts on human health, they also have differing impacts on the environment. Keeping that in mind we can develop sustainable eating practices that improve our own health as well as the health of the planet.

This has been widely researched and accepted that consumption of food from plant sources - fruits and vegetables, whole grains, pulses, legumes, nuts and seeds - improves health of human's vis-a-vis consumption of animals and animal produce. A diet,

on our plate, consisting of plant produces will nurture both - people and the planet. Such a change in dietary practices will also require major improvements in food production practices.

Production of animal based foods results in higher Greenhouse gas emission than producing plant based foods. Dairy and red meat (specially beef) are major contributors to this. We should move away from such food that places an enormous demand on our natural resources, results in deforestation, species extinction (because each specie has its own role in balancing the ecology of the planet) and fresh water depletion.

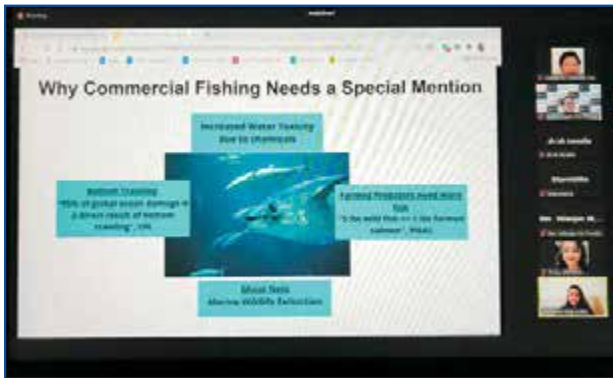

SEARCH, SEIZURE AND SURVEY-HOW YOU HANDLE IT

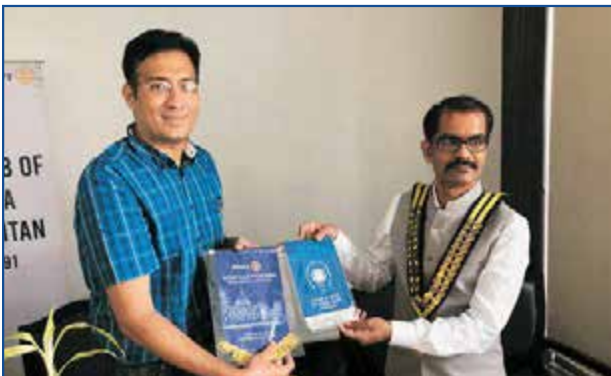

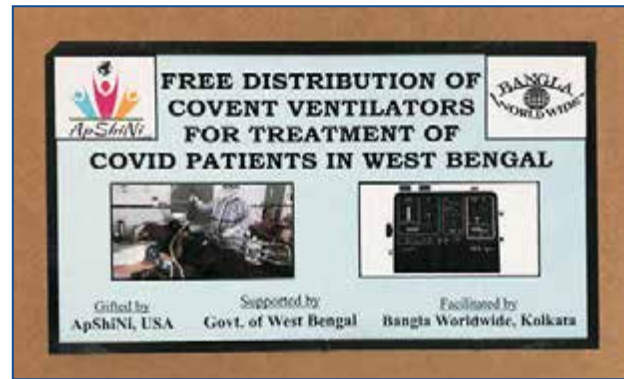
WE CARE FOR YOU-HANDING OVER OF VENTILATORS

DISTRIBUTION OF MASKS & SANITIZERS

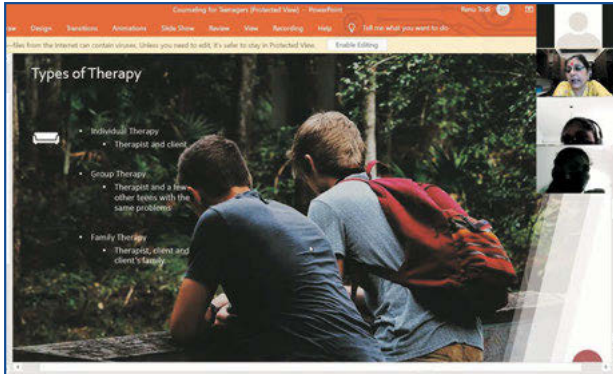
We distributed masks and sanitizers at Institute of Child Health (Park Circus) on 25.8.2021. This is a joint project with other clubs.

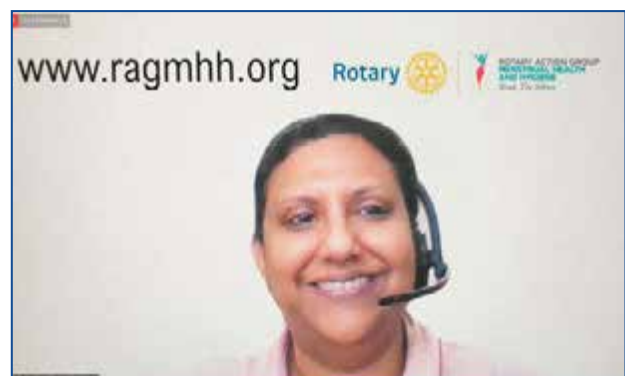
LIFE BEYOND CANCER-MUSICAL CONCERT FOR FUND RAISING

Though summer has started knocking on the door we still had a pleasant morning early on 6.3.2022 when we reached Lansdowne Market to distribute Garbage bins and Jute Bags. Being Sunday, the market was full of customers for daily routine buying and once the announcement was made that Jute bags were being made available @ Rs.10/- each, although the manufacturing cost was Rs.30/- each, the response of the buyers was excellent. The quality of Jute bags was also very good. There was huge rush of buyers and we found that people were willing to buy and use Jute bags instead of using the Plastic bags. In no time more than 1500 Jute bags were sold.

This program was jointly organized with "Concern for Calcutta", an NGO with the campaign "SAY NO TO PLASTIC CARRY BAGS". The enthusiasm from general public to participate in the campaign "NO PLASTIC BAGS" was commendable, which shows that now they are really concerned about the environments. We also distributed 10 Garbage Bins to those shops/vendors, who will use these for disposal of garbage and wastage only. Care was taken that bins are handed over to right shopkeeper/tea vendors.



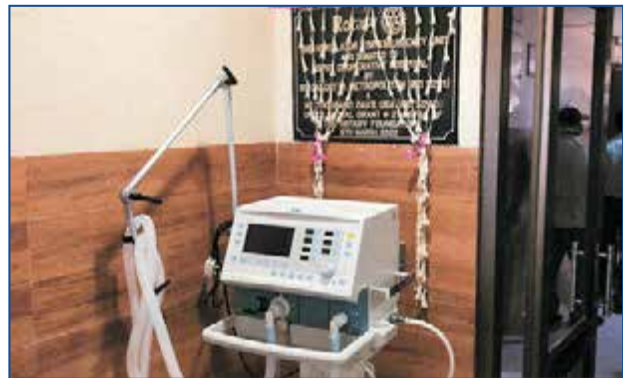


INAUGURATION OF OXYGEN PLANT AT ISPAT COOPERATIVE HOSPITAL - A LIFE SAVING INITIATIVE

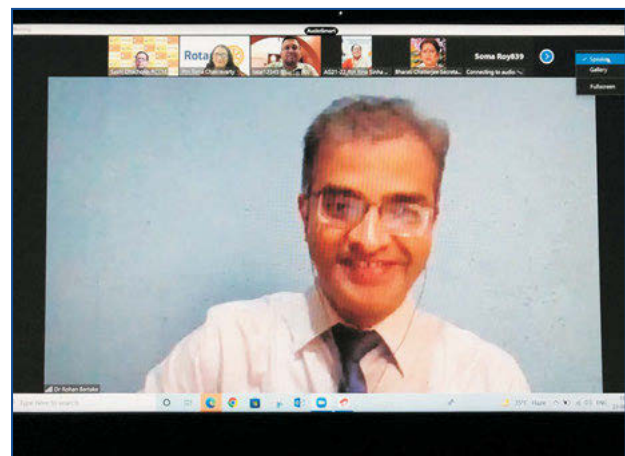
organizers. There were 60 donors out of 70 registered. We are thankful to RC of Calcutta Charnock City for meticulous planning and inviting us to join this project.

This is to appreciate and recognize the invaluable role played by Rtn Runjhun Gupta, a devoted Rotarian and a seasoned BNI Director in being a crucial communicator between several distressed families in India and their loved ones trapped in the Ukraine during the ongoing Russia-Ukraine conflict.

She witnessed multiple cases of requests shared for support on various channels of BNI network and took it upon herself to directly reach out to families, students, their families stuck in different parts of Ukraine, total adding more than 3000 plus students including the ones trapped in Indian medical school in Sumy, Ukraine.

Within few hours of requests, she along with her network had not only spoken to them but also arranged for to provide food and other assistance to the group.

What is also admirable is that not only did she personally coordinate the way till these students were evacuated from Sumy and other areas but did so right until they safely reached home.

We can only doff our hat to her for her dedication and yeoman service to humanity in this hour of crisis. In a situation when normal communication was difficult, official news unavailable or unreliable and wherein our government was doing its best to make a breakthrough, she was a beacon of hope to a lot of anxious families.





REPAIRING OF ROOF AT NUTON JIBON

Nuton Jibon, an orphanage needed badly repairing of their roof consists of tin sheets because of leakage of water during the monsoon.

This orphanage is situated near the Kalighat Police station and gives shelter and takes care of more than 52 abandoned children who were abandoned either by the street dwellers or the mothers of red light areas. We came to know about this orphanage thru our member Rtn Runjhun who also introduced us to Ms Jhumki Banerjee who runs this orphanage and has committed herself to saving lives of such deserted children.

During our last visit we saw that the roof had started leaking at many places and that was putting the children to great inconvenience. With rains round the corner we realised that the roof needed immediate repair. We also found that the gradient of the roof frame was not proper and puddles of water would sit on the roof sheets resulting in quick corrosion.

Members will be pleased to know that the work has since been completed and the roof stands repaired. The frames have also been corrected with proper slope and all defective sheets have been replaced. This work was completed by 31.5.2022.



REVIEW OF GG# 19-80213 OF REHABILITATION OF CEREBRAL PALSY CHILDREN

Due to pandemic conditions, the progress of Global Grant project no: 19-80213 was very slow during the last two years. With improved Covid conditions now, it was time to review the progress of this project. We visited MSS on 29.5.2022 led by our President Rtn Dr Somen Ghosh and other members to review Cerebral Palsy Children program where MSS is implementing agency.

Some equipment's under the above Global Grant project were seen in use by the beneficiaries. MSS authorities promised to take forward the project very soon. The actual delay because of pandemic conditions during last year, there New building at Joka was delayed. Now the work has started and MSS felt that it should be completed by March, 2023. Once the building is ready, then we expect with the supply of various equipment and others, the project will be completed next year.

The trainers of Disha India Education Foundation, Gurgaon unfolded a new horizon in front of the teachers to make teaching learning impactful. This type of skill development training is essential for the first generation learners of Piyali as it will help them to become self-dependent economically by creating different scope of earning for them.

The visiting team was highly impressed with the setting of the Oxygen Plant and made various queries. They also visited the cabin where Ventilator was placed and also Dialysis department, which according to them, is the best in the surrounding area. Even though the oxygen crisis may be over, but the plant of INR 30L + will still save them about INR 30L in 2 to 3 years, and that is net saving of 10 to 15 Lacs per year. Funds which can be used to impart affordable health care to the surroundings.
