








Due to pandemic conditions, the progress of Global Grant project no: 19-80213 was very slow during the last two years, things are now moving for Rehabilitation of Cerebral Palsy Children program where MSS is implementing agency.

Some equipment's under the above Global Grant project were seen in use by the beneficiaries. MSS authorities promised to take forward the project very soon. The actual delay because of pandemic conditions during last year, there New building at Joka was delayed. Now the work has started and MSS felt that it should be completed by March, 2023. Once the building is ready, then we expect with the supply of various equipment and others, the Global Grant project will be completed next year.

Further, we working on another Global Grants for Artificial Limbs and Callipers for physically challenged very soon.

'Every individual is a leader by itself started Rtn Madan Mohan Mohanka, who introduced Ms Bhawna Luthra, Executive Director of LEAD (Leadership Environment and Development) to the forum, ensuring she was there by taking care of her accommodation and flight...this itself was leadership in action and that's where Bhawna took up from and said that individually we all know what we don't want but collectively we create it. For eg, we don't want global warming or deforestation but it's our individual acts that are collectively causing it. So we need to become the change we wish to see. She spoke on "Leadership in Changing World" on 30.7.2022.

She quoted Mr Shyamal's colonial divide, where as per the latest stats 79 people in the world own 2/3rd of the world's wealth and there is further division between self and others. Self-divide leads to depression and suicides. The overall suicide percentage is much higher than the deaths in accidents or war and still there is no major drives on mental health. Hence in present context, bridging the divide is the work of leadership. Leadership is all about hope and solution.

Pandemic was the biggest test in proving it to us that leadership is dealing with not knowing what to do or knowing the solutions. Leadership is about being real and not the notion of larger than life and heroism as shown in movies. Collaboration, treating the youth at par, moving from ego systems to balancing eco systems is the path to new leadership.

Currently there are no role models in any spheres and that's what leads to people being disoriented as to whom to follow and hence today its even more important to find the inner voice and be your own leader.

Just like Nelson Mandela, who came out of the prison and had a momentary frown and later became the peaceful person he is known to be. When interviewed and asked for same, He answered, it was a moment of decision and he listened to his inner voice and chose forgiveness over revenge and that's why he is what he is today.

So leadership is not just in words, it's in making decisions and taking action.


COUNSELLING FOR GENERAL DUTY ASSISTANT (GDA)
