Biography of PDG Rtn Sylvia Whitlock, USA (District Governor 2012-2013)



PDG Rtn Sylvia Whitlock was born in New York City. She was educated through High School in Kingston, Jamaica and International baccalaureate from Cambridge University, England. Her other educational qualifications are B.A. Psychology - Hunter College of the City University of New York, M.A. - Education, Cal Poly, Pomona, PH. D. Education - Claremont Graduate School

M.A. Marriage and Family Therapy - Azusa Pacific University, California State Teaching and Administrative Credentials, Licensed in Marriage and Family Therapy by Board of Behavioral Sciences, California and Licensed Supervisor - Marriage and Family Therapy

She joined Ex-Rotary Club of Duarte in 1982 and held every office at club level. She is the first Woman President worldwide, in Rotary International and made up at clubs in England, Scotland, the Caribbean, Australia, South Africa, India. She chaired Four-Way Test Speech competition for 6 years and also Chaired Ambassadorial Scholarship Committee for 6 years. She also served on District Finance Committee and Chaired Simplified Grant Program and Served as Assistant Governor

She is recipient of Rotary Foundation District Service Award and recipient of Sylvia Whitlock award established and presented at the 2017 International Convention. She is also recipient of AFRAM GLOBAL Villager Award, 2019 and UNA Global Citizen Award 2013.

She participated in NIDS, established AIDS clinic in Jamaica, supported orphanage in Mexico, sank wells in Nigeria, raised almost \$90,000 for Education for Girls

in India. She is multiple Paul Harris Fellow, Benefactor and Member of the Bequest Society, and Major Donor She served as District Governor 2012-2013. She has spoken at more than 100 District Conferences, numerous clubs in the United States and overseas, Institutes and Zone events

Addressed all 530 incoming governors at 2013 International Assembly.

She is the Honorary Member of Rotary Club of Calcutta Metropolitan, Chicago One and Duarte Rotary. She is the member of the Rotary Club of Claremont, CA. She is member of the Board of Spanish Trails Girl Scout Council, Recorder for Blind and Dyslexic, Commission Member at Tri-City Mental Health Authority, Trainer in Mental Health First Aid, Volunteer at Pomona Valley Hospital, Chair of Pastor Parish Relations Council at Trinity U.M. church, Member and Past President of Beta Mu Chapter of Delta Kappa Gamma International.

Her Academic Activities are Chair of Western Association of Schools and Colleges Accreditation Teams, Member of California State Committee on Credentials at California State Department of Education (2004-2010), Distinguished Alumna at Cal Poly, Pomona, NAACP Woman of the Year

Hall of Fame and Hunter College, CUNY. 2021

Sylvia had three adult children, one of whom is Human Resources Assistant at University of California, Berkeley. She considers raising her children the most satisfying and enjoyable job she has ever had, almost comparable to enjoying her first grandson, and now a new granddaughter and another grandson. Cervical Cancer Vaccination Camp on 29.08.2021

On 29th August,2021 at PLC campus,102 beneficiaries aged between 9 to 14yrs were vaccinated to prevent cervical cancer. The team of doctors from CNCI had arrived and inoculated all the beneficiaries after verification of their registration cards issued to them in February,2021. The second dose of vaccine was provided 6 months after the first dose in February, 2021.


For the first time in Piyali, this vaccination camp was organized and there was spontaneous response from the community. Seventy-six PLC students meeting the age criteria were vaccinated. Entire arrangement was done in the PLC auditorium maintaining the safety protocols of the pandemic. The vaccination started from 10'0 clock in the morning and it took 4hours to complete the process.

Different time slots were arranged for the vaccinees in order to avoid gathering following the COVID guidelines. All the vaccinees were provided with snacks after the inoculation.

WEBINAR on Mental Health on 26.08.2021

"Health is wealth" the proverb indicates an explicit comparison of health with wealth, but we generally associate health with physical health. The importance of mental health is being ignored.

At PACE Learning Centre we really care for the mental being of everyone associated with it. The outbreak of pandemic has put us into solitary confinement which largely affected everyone's mental wellbeing especially the teenagers. Realizing the importance of the mental health a webinar on mental wellbeing has been organized by Rotary Club of Calcutta Metropolitan for PLC students.

For the first time students attended a virtual session on mental health issues. The webinar was conducted on 26th August,2021 on zoom by Rtn Renu Todi. The one and half hour session was attended by 35 students where teachers also took part. The session laid emphasis on anger management, peer pressure, parental pressure which are common problems for teenagers and different therapies to cope with these types of issues. The session being interactive proved to be very informative and helpful as Rtn Todi explained the topics with the help of a PPT. Very effective solutions were provided by Ms. Todi to deal with smartphone addiction and how to make the most out of it. Both students and teachers clarified their doubts on the issues discussed in the session and shared their views.

In this period of uncertainty and anxiety the idea of arranging this type of webinar opened so many doors for the students as they get expert opinion on the different mental anxieties they are struggling with and can move on happily.
