

Recently, Nick and I spent time in Guatemala, where we met wonderful fellow Rotary members and families who unofficially adopted me as "Tía Jennifer." On the third day, after visiting Patzún in the mountainous western highlands, we set out for Lake Atitlán, which we needed to reach by nightfall. If we took a back road we could get there faster. Locals told us it had just been repaved and assured us, "You'll have no problem."

At first, it was a breeze. We wound through misty-green coffee and corn fields covering the hillside like a patchwork quilt. But at a river crossing, we found a bridge washed away. The only way to continue would be to ford the river in our small bus. There were a few tense moments, but we decided to give it a try and, thankfully, we made it across safely.

This adventure reminds me of two important truths in Rotary. One, we rely on local, on-the-ground expertise to do what we do best. And two, sometimes you have to take uncomfortable chances to reach important goals.

Every day, I am honoured to learn from our Rotary family. Every lesson is an opportunity to grow, and each story adds a chapter to our collective Imagine Rotary year.

Rotary India Literacy Mission (RILM) has set a goal of making 5 crore adult literate by the year 2027. This is in sync with the Nav Bharat Shiksha Karyakram of Government of India where the government has planned to make 5 crore adults literate by 2027. Government of India and RILM, together plan to make 10 crore adults literate by 2027.

RILM is using a two-fold methodology of achieving this goal:

DIKSHA Each One Teach One (EOTO)

VIDYA Each One Teach Many (EOTM)

RILM invites all Indians, especially students of class VI and above to participate in this program. Together let us make India totally literate by ensuring that every adult in India is literate.

LAUNCHING OF ADULT LITERACY PROJECT

September being the Rotary Designated Month for "LITERACY", RC Calcutta Samaritans organized the following projects under Ee Zz eE School Project on 3rd September, 2022 in presence of Rtn. Sulekha Ghosh, District Adult Literacy Chair.

- 1. Inaugurated Adult Literacy classes with 40 beneficiaries (women) at the slum area of Dum Dum Park for their empowerment. Literacy Kits collected in the RY 2021-2022 from Rotary Club of Calcutta were handed over to the learners along with food packets.
- 2. Felicitated two educators of the Adult Literacy Centre with uttirio, sweet box and gifts on account of Teachers' Day on 5th September.
- 3. Conducted Menstrual Hygiene Awareness Camp amongst the women of the Adult Literacy Centre with distribution of Sanitary Pads.

Some Facts on literacy status of India.

- India's literacy rate is 77.70%. (Source: National Statistical Office India, 2021)
- 99.09% of children in India between the age group of 6-14 years are enrolled in school. (Source: UNESCO)
- There are 18.12 crore non-literate Adults in India (13.13% of India's total population)
- India houses highest number of adult non-literate in the world
- India can become totally literate when its adult non-literacy in eradicated. i.e, becomes literate and only then the literacy rate will rise beyond 90%.

RILM's Adult Literacy Program (Education for all) aims to impart functional literacy to non-literate adults (15+ age) across India towards increasing national literacy rate upto 90%.

Who is an adult non-literate?

- A person who is 15 years or above.
- A person who can't read aloud at a speed of 30 words per minute.
- · A person who can't read aloud and understand road signs, posters and newspapers.
- Does not understand and copy 7 words per minute.
- · Can't take dictation at the speed of 7 words per minute.
