Rotary International President 2022-23 Jennifer Jones

Jennifer Jones, 55, Rotary International President was born in Windsor, Ontario. The oldest of three children, she'd run lemonade stands to earn money to give to charity, and recalls organizing a carnival in her family's yard to benefit kids with muscular dystrophy.

"I've always wanted to carve my own path," says Jones. "Sometimes that's meant taking risks and making yourself open to new experiences." One of those was Rotary. At the Dallas training seminar in 1996, after wowing the crowd with her dance steps, she wins them with her speech. Her journey to victory begins.

Jones and husband Krayacich, governor-nominee of District 6400 are opposite in nature, complementing each other very well.

In 2009, when Jones was diagnosed with breast cancer, her days turned to chemotherapy and radiation. She got the diagnosis in the fall, and in January 2010, had been asked to speak at the International Assembly, the training for incoming district governors-elect. In consultation with her oncologist, she decided to attend it. "The Sunday before, I lost all of my hair," she says. "I showed up at the event in a wig."

"I wouldn't orchestrate having cancer again," she says, "but I can definitely say I wouldn't be sitting here where I am today if all of these things hadn't happened."

This is Rtn Jennifer Jones, Rotary International's first female president.


