### **TODAY'S GUEST SPEAKER**



Dr. Nandini Ray

Dr Nandini Ray is a renowned Ophthalmologist in Kolkata. Educated in the most distinguished Institutions in Calcutta (Modern High School, Calcutta Medical College) and London, UK (Royal College of Ophthalmologists), her early experience from March 1988 to December 1995 included positions such as SHO, Registrar and Locum Consultant Ophthalmologist at hospitals like Kings College Hospital, Newcastle General Hospital, Whipps Cross Hospital and Moorfields London.

After returning to Calcutta in January 1996, she has been attached as Consultant Ophthalmic Surgeon to Wockhardt Medical Centre and Wockhardt Hospital (now FORTIS HOSPITAL) and Woodlands Hospital.



Dr Ray specialises in Cataract surgery and Glaucoma surgery, having performed more than 18000 PHACO surgeries till date. She has recently trained in FLACS (Femto Cataract Surgery) and has been certified by Johnson & Johnson to operate on the Catalys Precision Laser System. Her specialisation aims for spectacle independence with premium advanced technology IOL's for which she has undergone training in the USA. She has presented about criteria for multifocal lens implantation at various conferences in India. She travels to conferences in Europe every year to be abreast with latest surgical and treatment modalities. Dr. Ray's special area of interest is PHACO surgery with premium lens, including correction of astigmatism and presbyopia with IOLs.

She has won the APARAJITA Award (Jurors Choice) in 2012 in the field of healthcare and has been awarded the IIRSI Special Gold Medal in 2016 for general proficiency in her field of work. She has also been awarded the Shree Nandini Award by the Fifth Note Global Company in April 2022. She has been honoured by her school Modern High School for Girls as an exceptional Distinguished Alum in 2021.

Her surgical videos on Complication Management in challenging cases has been accepted from a worldwide competitive entry by the ESCRS at Paris 2010, Vienna 2011, Milan 2012, Vienna 2018, Paris 2019 and Amsterdam 2021 that is six times in 11 entries between 2010-2021.

She is the sole proprietor of Radiant Eye Foundation, where she examines patients in a state of the art, homely and clean environment with the latest diagnostic facilities.

Dr Ray is fond of music, photography, films, travelling and cooking. She is a Rotarian since 1996 (Calcutta Midtown and now the Rotary Club of Calcutta) and a Paul Harris Fellow. She is a member of the think tank organization The Bengal Initiative as well as The Ladies Study Group which meets regularly to discuss ways to improve our environment and other topics. She is a member of the Indian Women Network (IWN) working towards womens' empowerment and a member of the General Committee The Bengal Club established in 1827.

Her husband Rtn Dr Abhrajit Ray, is a Senior Consultant Rheumatologist and her daughter Dr Meenakshi Ray is a Dental surgeon in the UK. Her son Dr Abhishek Ray has graduated with an MBBS degree from SRMC Chennai.

## 103<sup>RD</sup> INSTALLATION OF ROTARY CLUB OF CALCUTTA

Venue: Hotel Hindustan International, Kolkata

Date: 5th July, 2022

Time: 7.00 PM









Rotary Club of Calcutta, "theoldest continuing club in Asia", held its 103rd Installation with traditional splendour, on 5th July, 2022 at HHI, with live telecast of the entire program. On arrival of invited guests &dignitaries, Pres. Sujata commenced the proceedings by felicitating the Chief Guest, Guest of Honour and Special Guest and their spouces, with bouquet of flowers, before inviting PP Nilima Joshi to lead the National Anthem. In her brief speech she described the year's club activities, having concluded 180 projects valued at Rs 4 Crores, in spite of 6 months of Covid pandemic. Assisted by a Power Point presentation she highlighted how

projects addressed the '7 areas of Focus', including but not limited to, Covid vaccination, 'Akriti' – artificial limbs, Blood Analyser and equipment's for paediatric wards, mini water purification plant, computer schools, Selai schools, 'Hariyali'-Tree plantation, interfaith meetings, 'hot food on wheels', increased membership,- projects which emphasised skill development, were life changing & sustainable, and was aptly rewarded by District with the "Lions" Trophy. She then requested IP RIP Sekhar Mehta, to release the Annual Report for the year, announced the Rotarian of the Year for the B K Rohatgi Award to Rtn. Vikram Somany, following which she introduced the incoming Pres. Raj Kumar Agarwal, handed over Collar, Hammer & Gavel and the Charter, and expressed with a smile "the Lion needs to be caged in R C Calcutta and not released".

Pres. Raj commenced with traditional Lighting of the Lamp by all Guests on the dais to the sound of Ganesh Vandana hymn sung by Ayushmati Thakur, presented a Silver Salva each to the outgoing President and the Hony

Secretary, and followed by introducing the Directors to the audience, along with Club Officials and Committee Chairs. He then briefly outlined projects he has planned for the year, again assisted by a power point presentation, with Top Line focus areas being Literacy, Healthcare, Vocational Training, Rainwater Harvesting, WASH-5, Mangrove plantation, Blood Donor App, CCRC extension, multi club 'Kashmir Ladakh' project, and above all TRF contribution. At the request of Pres. Raj, Hony Secy Anand Sharma conducted the club business.

Pres. Raj then introduced Guest of Honour, DG Ajoy Law as the RIP's representative, who in his address extended thanks on behalf of RIP, and spoke of "Imagine Rotary" logo for year, implying member retention. In his speech he mentioned not to imagine yesterday, that's past, but imagine tomorrow. On conclusion Pres. Raj thanked him and presented a memento as a token of appreciation.

Pres. Raj then introduced Special Guest, RIDE Anirudha Roychoudhury, who expressed his deep sentiments on Late Samiran Sen, VP, on his untimely demise, and his decision to name the project 'where eagles dare' as SAMIRAN. He suggested to upscale projects with DDF funding and redesigning the Annual Report to make it more attractive for Corporates' CSR funds. On conclusion Pres. Raj thanked him and presented a memento as a token of appreciation.

Pres. Raj then introduced Chief Guest, IP RIP Sekhar Mehta, who referred to RC Calcutta's achievement for year 21-22 as "Girl Power". In his deep & insightful address he suggested all to have Big Dreams and proposed all Clubs to have a Strategic Plan for Goals spreading over 3 – 5 years, and opined big projects fulfilled within a year is technically not a big project, and cited the example of Polio eradication. He talked of his vision of making India completely literate by 2027, and progressively making the draft Education Policy of GOI adopting RILM's curriculum for Grade 1 thru Grade 10, and telecasting same through 10 nos e-vidya channels with a reach of 10 crores children daily. He spoke of Sikkim states' decision of free distribution 35,000 TV sets, out of which 5,000 has been earmarked for Rotary, which in turn RILM has arranged with OEMs Samsung & LG to be supplied with pre-fitted with Gr 1 to Gr 10 e-vidya channel, obviating need for tele connection. He spoke of gradual but slow growth of Major Donors, suggested Clubs to come together mentioning 'individual charity, but together it's philanthropy', it being the only way to make a difference and extend circle of life. On conclusion Pres. Raj thanked him with a loud round of applause from the audience, and presented a memento as a token of appreciation.

Pres. Raj then requested Rtn. Subhajit Guha Mazumder to raise a Toast to Ladies, and R. Ann Chandrima to reply to the Toast. Both spoke with elegance, quoting poets and Nobel Laureates, highlighting equality between men & women, compassion & understanding can only bring in a meaningful whole circle. Pres. Raj thanked them both and presented them with a memento each.

At the request of Pres. Raj, Rtn. Kanak Dutt, VP, delivered a Vote of Thanks. Pres. Raj then adjourned the meeting and invited all to an elaborate Fellowship and exquisite dinner.

The cycles were parked at Rotary Sadan since 29th June and were handed over on 7th July, '22.

One beneficiary was a Rotary Sadan office staff who cycles to work every day. The other two are ladies who cycle to the city daily from quite a distance to make their living. The ladies are 'single parent' and lost their jobs during pandemic because they used local train for commuting. These cycles will support them in getting jobs where people discourage using crowded public transport.

This was the penultimate project of Rotary Year 21-22, the last one being providing umbrellas to the city police, which will be concluded shortly.
