Topic: Polio - The end game strategy

An alumnus of Modern High School and Presidency College, Kolkata, Rtn. Shyamashree Sen is an academic outlier having topped the charts in both BA and MA in Political Science from Calcutta University. She began her work life as a copy writer for a couple of advertising agencies, newspapers and journals in India and abroad. Presently she is co-founder and partner of a Public Relations Company "Connections". # SIKSHA LABH 8 – LITERACY & BASIC EDUCATION

Location : Hatiara High Madrasah School

Date : 9th Sept, 2022 Time : 11.00 AM



The 8th phase of the project **SIKSHA Labh**, Literacy & Education opened at Hatiara High Madrasah School on 09.09.2022. The inauguration was done by PDG Rtn. Mukul Sinha (District Chair-Literacy) and by our President Rtn. Raj Kumar Agrawal. Rotarians present on the day included Dr. Hirak Sen, Dr. Atindra Nath Sen, PP Abhijit Kolay, Ashok Basu (AB4), Ravindra Khandelwal and Arindam Roy Chowdhury. This Computer Lab will provide Computer Education to 1000 students.

This school is a Govt. Aided Higher Secondary School with students from Class 5 to Class 12; the students primarily comprise of under privileged children from the nearby areas of Hatiara, Baguihati and other places. The student strength of this school is around 1000 with a coeducational facility. Nearly 1000 students will get benefit from this SIKHSA LABH project.

A special program was arranged by the students of the school with Rabindra Sangeet, a small recital of Gazal, and a small dance performance by a girl student of class 11. The Local Councillor along with the Chairman of the School Board were also present in the ceremony.

The 1st Club Assembly for Rotary Year was held at Rotary Sadan, and inaugurated by President Raj Agrawal & Hony. Secy Anand Sharma, in the presence of Zonal Secretary Pranay Agarwal. All Committees presented their activities during the 1st Qtr. along with future plans for the remaining 3 quarters of the year, and the Top Line items are captured hereunder.

Fellowship & Spl. Programmes - Sonal Worah: Children's Treat scheduled on 20th Nov, '22; Agomoni scheduled on 24th Sept, '22.

Community Services – Arindam Roy Chowdhury: Siksha Labh project under 'Brand' GUDDU, with a target of computer familiarization & training of 10,000 students/month; Anna Dann project of i) free milk to handicapped child patients thrice a week, and ii) Dry Food packets (aided by RILM); Selai Schools started receiving orders for dress making and earning potential fulfilled; Filter water supply by Tata Swach machines at 5 locations under "PRANADHAR" banner; Ananda Mela scheduled for 3rd Dec, to give free supply of 100 wheelchairs, 50 crutches etc.

Attendance & Green Badgers – Suman Chakraborty: Planning a Green Badgers meet (with internal speakers) to assist integration
Environment – Ashok Basu: Fruit tree sapling distribution at RCC (inculcating the ownership concept amongst children); planning tree plantation at Ayodhya Pahar school; Water Harvesting system along with pond clearance; partnering with Organic Farm

**Literacy – Sriranjani Joshi :** In addition to Siksha Labh project, planning Adult Literacy programs in those schools; implementing EASY School concept (in replacement of Happy School) with RILM assistance.

Vocational Services – Subhajit Guha Mazumdar: Organized Youth Skills Day and arranged computer Training for Kol Police (Traffic); planning vocational training for 'para' medics with Neotia's with job assurances for pass outs; training for Care givers for Alzheimer patients.

Special Projects – Partha Pratim Mukherjee: Organized Blood donation and Mega Health Camps, distribution of reusable Linen & Towel in slums & dog shelter homes, paper bag making from old newspaper, CEO Conclave; 10 projects lined up for development Ghoramara Island, Sunderban, jointly with RC Jamshedpur (West) as partner club

During Q&A, PPs Heena Gorsia, Haladhar Dey, Nilima Joshi helped President in many clarification & understanding. ZS Pranay Agarwal appreciated the Assembly process, and expressed that the heritage of 103 years old RC Calcutta was evident.
