### **Professor Tapati Guha-Thakurta**

Topic : Durga Pujas of Contemporary Kolkata – "The UNESCO Award"

Tapati Guha-Thakurta studied at Presidency College, Calcutta University, and the University of Oxford. She is currently an Honorary Professor of History at the Centre for Studies in Social Sciences, Calcutta (CSSSC) and was its former Director from 2012 to 2017. She has written widely on the art and cultural history of modern India and has held several visiting fellowships abroad. Her three main books are "The Making of a New Indian' Art: Artists, Aesthetics and Nationalism in Bengal" and "Monuments, Objects, Histories: Institutions of Art in Colonial and Postcolonial India", and "In the Name of the Goddess: The Durga Pujas of Contemporary Kolkata". She is also the author of some exhibition monographs — among



them, "Visual Worlds of Modern Bengal, The Aesthetics of the Popular Print" and "The City in the Archive: Calcutta's Visual Histories" - and has co-edited two anthologies of essays -"Theorising the Present: Essays for Partha Chatterjee" and "New Cultural Histories of India: Materiality and Practices". Since 1996, she oversaw the creation of a digital visual archive at the CSSSC that worked on documenting and cataloguing paintings, popular and commercial art, and photographs from different private collections in Kolkata. Among her recent assignments have been the setting up of the Jadunath Bhavan Museum and Resource, Kolkata (a unit of the CSSSC) in 2017, and the preparation in 2019 of a dossier on the Durga Pujas of Kolkata for the Ministry of Culture, Government of India, which has brought to the festival the coveted UNESCO inscription under its Representative List of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity.

She is here with us today to share with us her experience in the lead up to the UNESCO inscription.

### Eye Camp at Leh

#### Date: 11th,12th & 14th Oct, 2022 Time: 10.00 AM to 4.00 PM

The Kashmir/Ladakh steering committee organised its first project in Kashmir/Ladakh with a 3-day rolling Eye Camp in Leh. The constituent clubs were Rotary Club of London, Rotary Club of Calcutta, Rotary Club of Ladakh, along with Nanritam, Lokeswarananda Eye Hospital, Purulia. The Camps were held in SNM Hospital, Leh, on 11th Oct, Govt Hospital, Khalste, on 12th Oct, and Govt. Hospital, Diskit (Nubra) on 14th Oct.

The Camps offered free Eye Check-up, distribution of free spectacles and medicines. Rtn Dr. Debnath Chattopadhyay of RC Calcutta along with Ms Ranjana of Nanritam spearheaded and supervised the camps functioning while RC Ladakh organised & co-ordinated the 3-day event. Footfall at the camps on 1st day at Leh was 200 approx., 2nd day at Khaltse was 300, and 3rd day at Nubra it exceeded 353.

A detailed report will be published in the forthcoming Chaka.



This machine works on NANO technology which filters the viruses in the water, thus supplying pure drinking water. This supply prevents the community from water borne diseases. This project will benefit 5000+ people in the community. Presently all the machines were installed in the respective places and the utilization of the machines has started benefiting the community.
