

SIKSHA LABH - Educate 4,000 + students in Govt Schools





RC Calcutta launched "Siksha Labh" a flagship project right at start of the new Rotary year 22 – 23, a directional approach to IP RIP Sekhar Mehta's Vision of "making India completely literate by 2027".

Siksha Labh envisages educating 4000+ students in Govt schools by making computer labs in schools. The project was inaugurated on Installation Day, by gifting 5 computers through DG Ajoy Law, to Kamalpur Kamala Balika Vidyamandir, in Jessore Road, Dum Dum. This school has a student strength of 350, and the formal computer Lab inauguration was on 18th July, '22. The project entails computer Lab creation in schools, and the number of computers earmarked is 100 in aggregate. The funding is from individual voluntary donation from Club members, with a price tag of Rs. 14,000/- per computer inclusive of peripherals and UPS. As at time of going to press donations for 40 nos. computers has been received from 11 kind-hearted club member donors.

The entire project will be rolled out during the course of this Rotary year.
