VISIT TO RCC BISHNUPUR









Chair Environment Ashok Basu and Secretary Rtn Anand Sharma visited RCC Bishnupur on Wednesday, 17th Nov. 2022 in the morning. This was to review the work done for clearing a pond of hyacinth and other material that had clogged the pond post amphan and no work could be done in course of the pandemic. About 20 families are dependent on the pond for all their daily needs. The RCC also used the pond for pisciculture to raise funds commercially by sale there of. The complete clogging of pond had disabled all these essential activities. With the support of the Club, the pond is now cleared of hyacinth mostly. An interesting feature is that water monitors and other life also use the pond and in turn carry algae back into the pond, and this must be cleaned periodically, which however is not so much of a comprehensive exercise. The introduction of fish will also clean algae naturally. Our support has therefore holistically recreated a water source that is vital for sustaining life. It was heartening to note from a beneficiary that this pond is "Ma Ganga".

The visit also provided the opportunity to review all the other activities of the RCC, particularly the school. It was a delight to see the young kids going through the motions of school life with enthusiasm. We met some of their teachers who explained the method of holistic education that the Aurobindo Ashram curriculum is designed for. Teachers are well motivated and are sent to Ashrams in Puducherry and Delhi for training and retraining. For Secretary Anand Sharma this was the first visit to the RCC, and he was given a complete walk through of the school and its various activities. Sewing Machines provided by us are being well used. The new school building is fully functional and some more infra development work was visible. They are digging from some parts of their property to raise the ground in the areas adjoining the school building to make it free of water logging which can then be used for sports, gymnastics etc. The school is gearing up for registration with West Bengal Board of Secondary Education.

They have requested from us some park and play equipment like slides etc. for use by the tiny tots and some more ponding activity. We will consider these once we receive written requests covering full details of cost and benefits.
