RUPA CHAKRAVARTI DRAUPADI GLOBALLY

Rupa Chakravarti, spouse of Ambassador Sarvajit Chakravarti, retired, formerly Secretary to Govt. of India, is a global educator, having taught in International Schools in New Delhi, Dhaka, Windhoek, The Hague, Rotterdam, Moscow, Brussels, and Ljubljana. Her expertise includes teaching in Primary, Middle School, Secondary including, IGCSE, O LEVELS, A LEVELS, & IB ENGLISH B. Chakravarti has also taught Business English Cambridge, to executives in multinational corporations like, Janssen - Cilag in Milan.

She graduated with English Honours, followed by a Master's degree in Education and accreditations from Cambridge University, in both English Language and Literature, providing her with examinor status globally. She has served as Advisor / Consultant, (Bridge International





School, Kolkata). A TEDex speaker, she is the author of 3 books. The first, Pilgrimage - supported by Dr. Shashi Tharoor, Ex Foreign Secretary, Ambassador Nirupama Rao, and Shri Jawhar Sircar, is a book of poems, tracing the life of Krishnokoli, through translations of Tagore and her original poems. Her 2nd book, 'Bidisha and Bureaucracy', supported by Member of Parliament, Ambassador Pavan Varma, and Ambassador Shiv Shankar Mukherjee, is a glimpse into her life as a diplomatic spouse. Her 3rd book, 'Teaching Globally: The Untold Story...' is a compilation of pedagogy through narrative and anecdotal references, including 12 world renowned educators, including Dr. Kevin Bartlett, her colleagues, and friends of over 2 decades.
