## SIKSHA LABH 3 -- LITERACY & BASIC EDUCATION

Location: Bustee Welfare Society, Lovelock Place, Ballygunge

Date : 29th July, 2022 Time :11.00 AM



The 3rd phase of the project **SIKSHA Labh**, Literacy & Education was opened at Bustee Welfare Society, Lovelock Place, Ballygunge on 29.07.2022 by our President Rtn. Raj Kumar Agarwal in the presence of our club members. Almost 16 Rotarians were present in the ceremony. This school was established in the year 1968 by Late Smt. Sheila Davar with a mission to educate the under-privileged children of the slum areas of South Kolkata. Later the school also started to Empower the girls in their livelihood with vocational training and making the women self-dependable. Presently the school has a strength of **500 students** coming from the nearby areas of Ballygunje. In this project a Computer Lab has been created with an installation of 9 nos. of new Computer Sets along with 9 nos of UPS. The computer lab will benefit around 500 students with basic computer education every month.

The students performed cultural programs along with songs, poems and dances. Our own Rtn. Dr. Joshita Davar Khemani and Rtn. Dr. Sourabh Khemani organized a cake cutting ceremony which was truly enjoyed by all the visiting Rotarians.

With the opening of the 3<sup>RD</sup> project under SIKSHA LABH, the total no. of benificiaries stands to 2350 students total with three schools.

- 4. President welcomed Mr. Rajesh Kumar, IPS, as the Chief Guests.
