She is the second lady President of ICSI in the illustrious history of the Institute of 52 years. The Institute has 72 chapters spread across the length and breadth of the country, with more than 50,000 members and approximately 3,50,000 students.

Mamta Binani is a commerce graduate, a Fellow Member of the Institute of Company Secretaries of India and has done her LLB.

She has been a meritorious student throughout her education career. She was an All India Topper in the Intermediate Examinations of The Institute of Company Secretaries of India, amongst all the lady candidates in India and had ranked 14th on an All India basis. She was practicing as a Company Secretary for over 22 years and was a senior partner of Mamta Binani & Associates, having its offices in Pune, Kolkata, and Chennai. She is now practicing as an Advocate and is also a consultant on restructuring, corporate and legal matters.

She is the first insolvency professional in the country, to be registered with the Insolvency & Bankruptcy Board of India. She also serves as an Independent Director on a few of the prestigious Boards and has served as the promoter director of the ICSI Insolvency Professionals Agency (now known as ICSI Institute of Insolvency Professionals).

She has been conferred with the 'Bharat Nirman Awards' in the year 2010 for 'Excellence in Professional Services and is the first Company Secretary to have received this prestigious award and also the 'KKMERS' Award for 'Excellence in Profession'. She also received the 'Tejaswini Award' in the year 2010. She was conferred with the 'Hello Kolkata' award for exemplary work in the social sector.

"Wah Zindagi" has featured a telefilm on her journey which is widely viewed on YouTube. She has been covered by the BBC World for a documentary on the usage of 'Ghee' and is the only practicing company secretary to have been featured by FEMINA magazine in one of its coveted anniversary issue. She has been conferred with the 'The Sculptors Bhavishya Ke Shilpakar Awards-2020' in recognition of her contribution to society. She was shortlisted for the Quinquennial edition - "Who's Who of the World 2021" which is an extremely prestigious collector's selection of the most remarkable personalities globally.

Dr. Binani is a regular and acclaimed speaker in the professional forums on subjects of contemporary and academic professional interest including interpersonal & communication skills. She takes a keen interest in delving into corporate and professional issues and is consulted on various corporate matters by the Industry. 
