SITE VISIT AND RECCE OF PROJECT SAMARTH



Project Samarth, one of the Clubs largest community service projects – distribution of 650 wheel chairs and 100 sewing machines - gets off the ground on 17th Dec, 2022. A recce of the project venue, the historic Princep Monument grounds, was conducted on Sunday, 27th Nov.

Senior leadership of President Raj, PP Saumen Ray, CYP Purnendu and Rtn Subhajit Guha Mazumdar marked present and valuable advice and suggestions were made. The meticulous planning made by Arindam Roychowdhury, Chair, Community Service and his team of live-wire co-chairs, Yogesh Dassani and Ravindra Khandelwal was in evidence. Starting with the movement of the wheelchairs and Sewing Machines in large numbers, locating the seating for the beneficiaries, backdrop, first-aid camp, registration desk, food and water distribution kiosks, seating for Rotarians, wheelchair support wherever required, all aspects of the event flow was discussed and finalised. This project is a time critical and logistics critical one. Managing this at the micro level on the ground requires a dedicated team of volunteers. 97[™] ANNUAL CHILDREN'S TREAT

It is a great reason for us to be grateful and proud to be associated with this August Club which is carrying on with its longest running Community Project in Asia, the 97th Annual Children's Treat held on 20th November 2022 at Nicco Park with 1100 children from 21 organisations.

The day started with school buses sponsored for the day by South Point School, 5 in number, and 10 by DPS Ruby Park, thanks to Rtn Sanjeev Agarwal, registering at Rotary Sadan at 6:30 a.m. Rtns K. K. Kothari, who kindly sponsored samosa, gatia and chai for drivers and all, Purnendu Roy Chowdhury, Yogesh Dassani, Anand Sharma, Anand Bhuwalka and myself along with 25 odd Rotaractors led by Sonal Baid were present to register each bus, and equip it with breakfast, Frooti, badges etc. for the children and despatch it to respective schools. On reaching Nicco Park, the children were welcomed with hot energy drink sponsored by Rtn Kanak Dutta, and a bright yellow Rotary cap. They then assembled in the shamiana for the address by our Chief Guest D.G. Rtn Ajoy Law. Soon after, the children were led to the various 6 rides allowed by the authorities. The whole park dawned the sprinkling of yellow caps all over accompanied by 'whoops' of laughter and unbridled joy as the children carried on with the toy train ride, the carousel, the cup and saucer ride etc. Tired, but happy they trooped back in the shamiana for sumptuous lunch veg and non-veg, served with love and contentment by around 25 Rtns, Ann's, Spouses. After lunch, the children were treated to a Magic Show which was a great hit going by the claps and cheer it received! Too soon, it was time to shepherd the children back in their buses.





Before leaving, each Organisation was presented with a set of badminton rackets, shuttles, and net. Each child was presented with a school bag containing a Hoopla toy sponsored by Rtn Sharmistha Koya, chips sponsored by Sumangla Murarka, Oreo biscuits sponsored by Sonal Worah, pencil case with pencil set, copy books, got by Partha Mukherjee at a subsidised rate, chocolates donated by RILM. Each bus was also provided with soft drinks for the children on their way home by Rtn Goenka. The happy, joyous sated looks on the children's faces as they were leaving, the cheerful bye-byes aptly explained why this fabulous project is carrying on for 97 years and will continue to do so, by God's grace, in the years to come.

The detailing of the program has been oft covered in The Chaka and Rotary News so this signature event of our Club is now known to all, to use the editor's lexicon 'From Cape Comorin to Kashmir'.

The current year's event now serves as a heads up to its own Centennial coming up in the Rotary Year 2025-26! Post the Club's Centenary Event, this one in 2025-26 will doubtless serve to again re-enforce the Club's pre-eminence in

India, Asia, and the World.
