Jewellery designer, Social and Peace Activist, Media/Corporate Communications Consultant, Pranic healer, Tarot reader and Numerologist.



MINUTES OF THE 4822nd MEETING FOR THE REGULAR WEEKLY MEETING HELD ON 3 AUGUST 2021 AT 1 PM ON ZOON

- 1 President Sujata Pyne called the 4823 rd Regular Weekly
- 2 Meeting of the Club to order.
- 3 President welcomed the attending guests and Rotarians.
- 4 National Anthem was played on screen.
- 5 Minutes of the 4822 nd Regular Meeting held on 31 st July, 2021 on zoom were confirmed.
- 6 The President thanked Rtn Samiran Sen for excellent work of on-time delivery of Chaka every week.
- 7 The President announced:
 - a. Visit to spastic society during the weekend led by the Committee Chair, Arindam Roy Chowdhury. 80 children along with their attendants will be provided lunch and goodie bags.
 - b. 15 August 2021 Independence day programme at Rotary Sadan at 10 am. DG, Prabir Chatterjee would attend for flag hoisting and launch "AKRITI" the prosthetic limbs project. Since D.G has declared the day as "Rotary Day for Empowering Girls", the launch of the project would be specifically for women beneficiaries. This would be followed by the "Monsoon Food Festival" of exotic spread, at Leelabati Resorts, Kasba a fund raising lunch where members may contribute in multiples of Rs. 500/- for the project "AKRITI", though the amount per Leg is Rs. 2500/- and Rs. 3000/-for hand.
 - c. The President requested the members to pre-register for joining the Food Festival with Anjan Behera of Rotary Sadan to help headcount and prevent wastage of food.
 - d. Donation of 35 sewing machines to RCCs to give training, and jobs to the women who can also market their products through RCCs.

 - f. Formation of Newspaper Committee to be chaired by Rtn Anusua Das and Rtn. Launch of "ARANYAK" project at Taj Bengal on Friday, 6th August 2021. President welcomed the members to join.
 - g. Appealed to the members to introduce the next generation for membership of the Club to carry on the legacy.

So please book your dates and time. Your participation will mean a lot.


