presence of about 30 members of the club including eminent doctors.

It was organised with precision and systematic operations that ensured peaceful execution.

On the 2nd day of the Vaccination Drive, a parallel blood donation camp was conducted within airconditioned buses where 68 donors exhibited their generosity by making the most valuable contribution of their blood for government hospital blood banks. The first phase of vaccination ended on Thursday, 22 July after 3 days.

When an example was set by 4 visually challenged blood donors making it more than a successful and satisfactory event to be remembered by many for years to come. 
