Commodore Srikant B Kesnur

Cmde Srikant Kesnur, an alumnus of the prestigious National Defence Academy, was commissioned in the Indian Navy in July 1986. In his 35 year career he has had extensive experience in maritime operations, training, leadership, diplomacy, and communication. He has been the Captain of two frontline ships and, in addition, his tours of duty have witnessed several important assignments, prestigious courses and interesting tenures - at sea, ashore and abroad. He was also the Defence Adviser at the High Commission of India, in Nairobi, Kenya, from Oct 2008 to Mar 2012, with Kenya, Tanzania, Seychelles, Eritrea and Somalia as his area of responsibility.

He has a PhD from Mumbai University apart from five postgraduate degrees in science and social sciences. He has been senior faculty at



Navy/Military colleges and training institutions. He has also been the lead writer and Chief Editor of nine books and many journals for the Indian Navy. In addition, he has been involved with several academic, creative and corporate outreach endeavours of the Navy. He is presently the Director of Maritime Warfare Centre, Mumbai as also the Officer in Charge of Naval History Project.

He has been conferred the Vishisht Seva Medal (VSM) in the Republic Day awards 2021.

A Mega Blood Donation Camp was organised by RC Calcutta at Rotary Sadan on 4th Sept '21, a joint initiative with District 3291. The event was partnered with RC Calcutta Jadavpur and RC Tollygunge. MLA Debasish Kumar inaugurated the project, and jointly with DG Prabir Chatterjee solemnised the event by lighting the Ceremonial Lamp. The Lamp lighting ceremony was assisted by President Sujata Pyne, Sriranjani Joshi, Secretary, Sushil Bagla and other dignitaries. PDG Brojo Gopal Kundu and PDG Pinaki Ranjan Ghosh shared the dais and blessed the occasion.

RC Calcutta had publicised the benefits and humanitarian services extended through blood donation, and adequately informed as to who can donate blood. 'Donor screening formalities' had been pre-arranged and all donor data was recorded, before blood extraction. A large contingent from Calcutta Police had presented for voluntary blood donation.

One of the first donors was District First Lady, Rubena Chatterjee, with past Secretary Subhajit Guha Mazumder and Arindam Roychoudhury donated from our Club. From Calcutta Police there were 40 donors. In aggregate 63 units of blood was donated during the camp period. All donors were deeply thanked, that their contribution will help Thalassemia patients, and a packet containing snacks was gifted from the club as a token of appreciation.


