10th October 2021- VISITING RCC
 DEARRA – Donation of desktops for computer Centre

Rotarians visited RCC Diarra on the 10^{th of} October 2021. 2 desktops for the computer center were donated. A room for the new computer center was identified and plans to set up a Wi-Fi zone were discussed. The computer training center will be used to improve literacy. There is also a plan to employ an experienced person to teach the teachers the basic computer skills. A Cheque for teachers' salary was also given to the school.

Saris were given to the teachers as a Pujo gift.RCC wanted an Eye camp, which will be organized if the Covid situation remains stable.

Education Scholarship (on going monthly project). Rs 10000 was given to needy 10 girl students (with single parent) to continue their studies in English medium schools - done in association with SD Ahuja foundation.

> 14th October 2021 - Clean Kolkata Campaign

To keep Kolkata clean and to stop littering of Kolkata roads, Rotary club of Calcutta Inner City has teamed up with Kolkata on Wheels. We are distributing blue bin bags which can be tied to the back of the car front seat. Litters in the car can be kept in this bag and disposed of properly later.

50 bin bags were distributed with the help of PP Smarajit Mitra.

23rd October 2021 Supplying food for the needy

This is an ongoing project initiated and sponsored by Rtn Amitava Ghosh. Rs 8000 was given to Nitai Pradhan who supplies food packets to the Robin Hood Army. This is for supplying 50 packets of food at Rs 16 per packet to the poor in Kolkata every weekend for the 10 weekends this year starting from today.

Rotary Club of Calcutta Inner City successfully vaccinated needy people with free Covishield vaccine (second dose) in association with Fortis Hospital. The drive was funded by Rotary Club of Calcutta Inner City. There were 55 recipients. The drive was conducted in a safe environment with designated appointment slots to prevent overcrowding. The first vaccination camp to prevent Covid infection was held in July 2021.
