



### HOPE FOR FIGHTING A GLOBAL SCOURGE

To Everyone in our Rotary Family,

While sitting with a group of Rotary leaders outside of Lusaka, Zambia, I ask a question: "How many of you have ever had malaria?" Every hand in the room goes up. They even begin to tell me about the first, second, or third time they experienced the disease, one of the main causes of death and sickness in many developing countries.

They are fortunate. They have access to medical treatment and lifesaving medicines. For the people of rural Zambia, their story is very different.

On a wooden bench in a small village, I sit with Timothy and his young son Nathan. With a camera crew capturing our conversation, he tells me of the time Nathan showed signs of malaria. He brought the boy to the nearby home of a community health worker, where Nathan quickly received medicines that in all likelihood saved his life.

Calmly, Timothy tells me about his other son's bout with the disease a few years earlier. He had to race that son to a medical clinic more than 5 miles away. Riding a bike and carrying his child on his back, he tells me, he could feel his son's legs turn cold and then his little body go limp. As he finally entered the clinic, he screamed for help, but it was too late. The camera stops rolling, and we sit in silence. He begins to weep, and I hold him tightly. "I lost my son, I lost my son," he says.

This story is all too familiar for the families we meet over the next few days. And yet there is hope. Partners for a Malaria-Free Zambia is Rotary's first Programs of Scale grant recipient, and it is saving lives. Across two provinces of Zambia, 2,500 volunteer health workers have been selected by their communities. They are trained to bring medical care closer to those who need it, and they are able to diagnose and treat malaria and other ailments. I invite you to read in this issue about Rotary partnerships that create lasting change.

### **History of The Rotary Foundation**

At the 1917 convention, outgoing RI President Arch C. Klumph proposed to set up an endowment for the purpose of doing good in the world.

In 1928, it was renamed The Rotary Foundation, and it became a distinct entity within Rotary International.

In 1929, the Foundation made its first gift of \$500 to the International Society for Crippled Children. The organization, created by Rotarian Edgar F. "Daddy" Allen, later grew into Easter

When Rotary founder Paul Harris died in 1947, contributions began pouring in to Rotary International, and the Paul Harris Memorial Fund was created to build the Foundation.

The recognition consists of a certificate and

### CERTIFICATE OF APPRECIATION

Occasionally, a donor contributes US\$1,000 and wishes to recognize a business or organization In these instances, since Paul Harris Fellow recognition can only be presented to individuals, a Certificate of Appreciation is given instead.

### MULTIPLE PAUL HARRIS FELLOW

Multiple Paul Harris Fellow recognition is extended at subsequent \$1,000 levels (e.g., \$2,000, \$3,000). Recognition consists of a pin with additional stones corresponding to the recipient's recognition amount level

### PAUL HARRIS SOCIETY

The Paul Harris Society is a district-administered recognition for those who elect be person contribute USS1 100 or more each year to the Annual Programs Fund, PoliciPius, or Rotary Foundation Matching Grants (for nonpilot districts) or Rotary Foundation Global Grants (for Jo districts), Individual districts handle all associated recognition for this program, and inquiries should be directed accordingly. Paul Harris Society contributions are eligible toward Rotary Foundation Sustaining Member, Paul Harris Fellow, and Major Di

1947 The Foundation established its first program, Fellowships for Advance Study, later known as Ambassadorial Scholarships.

Three programs were launched: Group Study Exchange, Awards for Technical 1965-66 Training, and Grants for Activities in Keeping with the Objective of The Rotary Foundation, which was later called Matching Grants.

Rotary introduced the Health, Hunger and Humanity (3-H) Grants. The first 3-H

1978 Grant funded a project to immunize 6 million Philippine children against polio.

1985 The PolioPlus program was launched to eradicate polio worldwide.

The first peace forums were held, leading to Rotary Peace Fellowships. Future Vision: New district, global, and packaged grants enable Rotarians around the 2013










### **INAUGURATION OF CT SCAN MACHINE AT JAY AMBE HOSPITAL, CHAPARDA**


