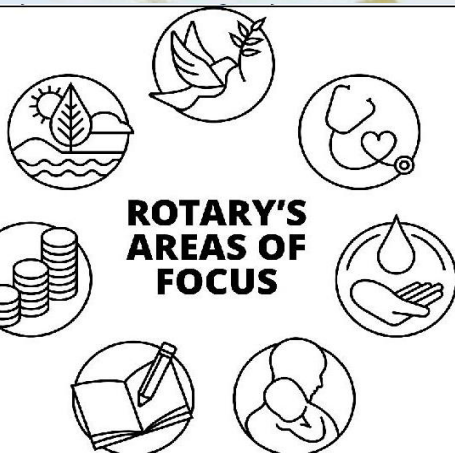

In 1932, Rotarian Herbert J. Taylor created The Four-Way Test as a moral code for personal and business relationships. The test, which has been translated into more than 100 languages.

What is a rotary minute?

Rotary Minute is a monthly video series that features Rotarians around the world, sharing their thoughts about topics that interest them.

What is the object of Rotary?

The Object of Rotary is to encourage and foster the ideal of service as a basis of worthy enterprise and, in particular, to encourage and foster: **FIRST**. The development of acquaintance as an opportunity for service; **SECOND**.

What do Rotary clubs do?

“Rotary is an organization of business and professional person united worldwide who provide humanitarian service, encourage high ethical standards in all vocations and help build goodwill and peace in the world.” Some Rotary clubs use the official Rotary flag as a banner at club meetings.

What is a Junior Rotarian?

The Jr. Rotarian program is where Rotary clubs host students from local schools to provide networking opportunities and career discussions with Rotarians. It is where a lot of students have their first introduction with Rotary.



ROTARY PRESIDENT 2022-23 RTN JENNIFER JONES



In August, I was proud to visit Pakistan and highlight Rotary's top goal, eradicating polio. It was also a tremendous opportunity to spotlight female health workers who are playing a critical role in protecting children from this vaccine-preventable disease.

This month, as we celebrate World Polio Day, we are shining a spotlight on our more than 30-year effort to lead the first global polio eradication campaign and our success in forming partnerships capable of completing this massive goal. We all know that this is one of the most ambitious global health initiatives in history and that we've reduced polio cases by more than 99.9 percent worldwide.

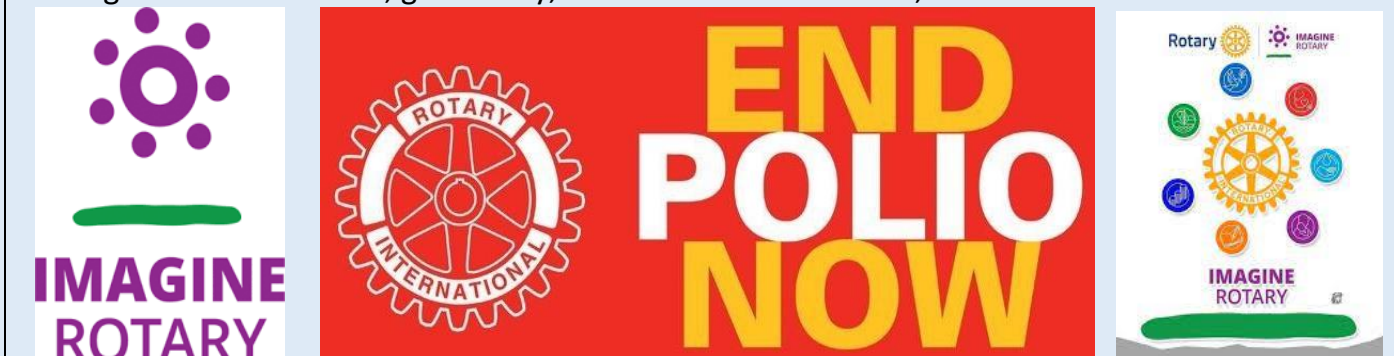
Pakistan is one of only two countries in the world where wild poliovirus remains endemic. (The other is neighboring Afghanistan.) I was able to witness and take part in vaccination campaigns in Pakistan, and soon after I left, a monumental nationwide immunization campaign took place, focused on 43 million children under the age of 5. I saw the incredible work of Rotary members on the ground. More than 60 percent of vaccinators in Pakistan are women, and they are doing a remarkable job building trust and convincing mothers to vaccinate their children.

Seeing it all firsthand, I know that the will exists across the Rotary world to end polio, and I'm confident that we have the strategy. The Pakistani media has been very supportive of our efforts as well, and this is making a difference. This month, a new global pledging moment at the World Health Summit in Berlin promises to pull together more resources to fund these time-sensitive eradication efforts. Now it is up to us to do our part and raise \$50 million this year to earn the full 2-to-1 match from the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation.

There's great cause for optimism on the polio front — but also some staggering new events that have further raised the stakes. Over the past few months, new polio outbreaks have occurred in Israel, the United Kingdom and, most recently, in the New York City area. These stories are frightening, but in every case, the response is clear — vaccines work, and if polio is spreading, we need to make sure the most at-risk people have kept their vaccinations up to date.

Most importantly, we need to eradicate this virus now. If polio exists anywhere, it can spread everywhere. What I saw in Pakistan convinced me that we can and must finish the job, but it will only happen if we remain committed to a strategy that's working and back it with all necessary resources.

Through our commitment, generosity, and sheer determination, we will #EndPolio.

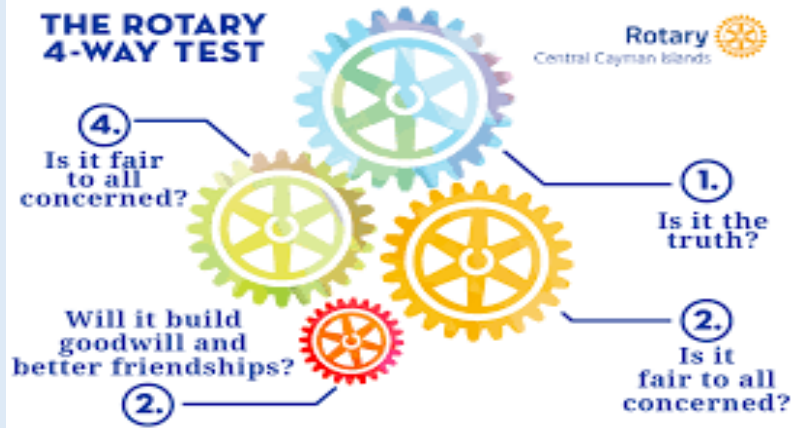

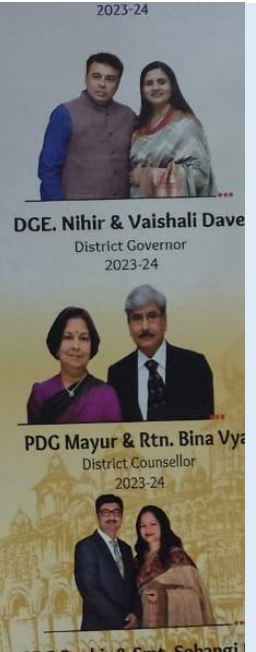

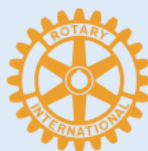

PROJECT NAME: FREE MOBILE BLOOD COLLECTION SERVICE

AIM: To create awareness to donate blood amongst local population especially in the rural areas and motivate people to donate blood and after collection donate to Blood Banks in Chikhli, Valsad, Billimora, and Navsari.

DESCRIPTION: Blood donation camps are reduced after Covid-19 Pandemic. Blood stocks in the Blood Banks have drastically reduced due to lesser donors willing to donate blood hence we intend to acquire a vehicle fully equipped with all the modern facilities and equipment to get blood from the donors right inside the vehicle and bring awareness amongst people and motivate them to donate blood on regular basis.

Rotary Club of Chikhli River had organised Blood Donation Camps at various places in association with Blood Banks of Chikhli, Billimora, Valsad and Navsari.

The blood samples which we collect in the vehicle will be taken Free of Cost from the donors and shall be donated to these blood banks which will be Free of Cost.



The blood collection vehicle shall look like the above vehicle which will be fully airconditioned and well-equipped and shall have collection facilities right inside the vehicle itself.

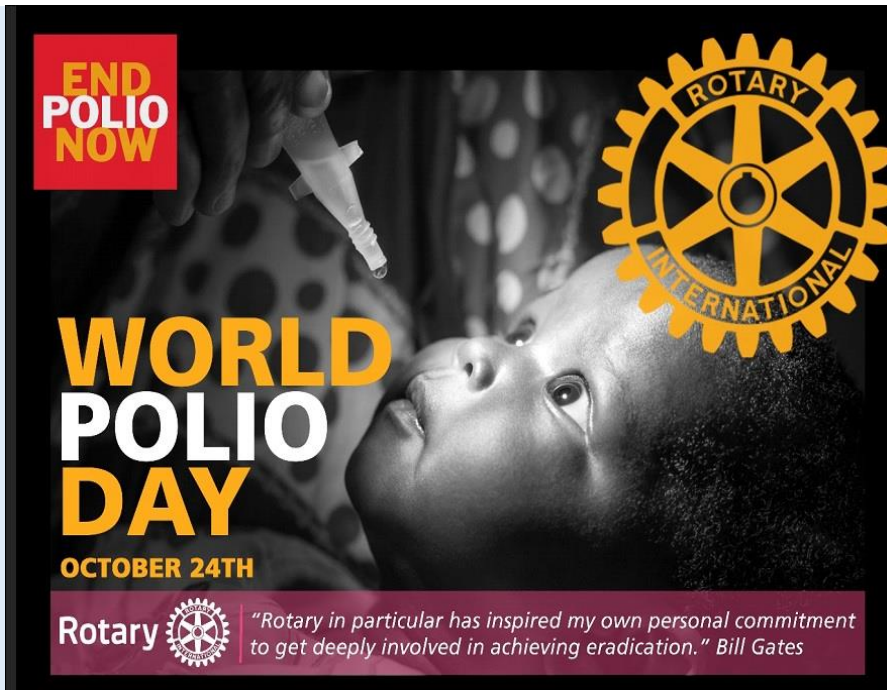

World Polio Day is observed annually on October 24. The day raises awareness about the disease and honours the global efforts toward a polio-free future, as well as the selfless sacrifices of those working on eradicating polio from every corner of the world.

Polio is contagious due to the ease with which the poliovirus spreads. Although the virus is now exceedingly rare because of modern interference, it can impair the brain regions that govern respiration, resulting in death. Polio, which has no recognized therapy, can only be avoided through vaccination.

Few interesting facts about Polio

- Polio (poliomyelitis) primarily affects children under the age of five. Hence children are mostly affected by the disease.
- One in 200 infections results in permanent paralysis and when their respiratory muscles become immobilized, 5% to 10% of paralyzed people die.
- To take action against polio, many countries have increased their ability to monitor and immunize their populations through a global effort.
- There were around 350,000 cases of polio worldwide in 1988, however, this figure has since dropped to only 37 confirmed cases in 2016.
- Polio can spread across the globe as long as there is a single person who is still carrying the disease.
- Polio is an infection caused by a virus that affects the entire body, including muscles and nerves.
- There are 3 types of polio: non-paralytic (does not lead to paralysis), spinal-paralytic (can result in the paralysis of one or more limbs), and bulbar (can result in weak muscles, reflex loss, and respiratory problems).

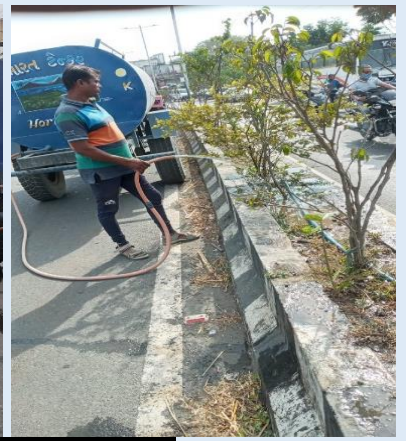

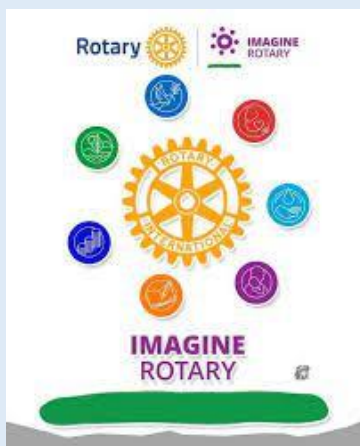

IPDG Rtn Santosh Pradhan himself had cultivated a small Farm of a marginalised farmer in this picture which was encouraging gesture.



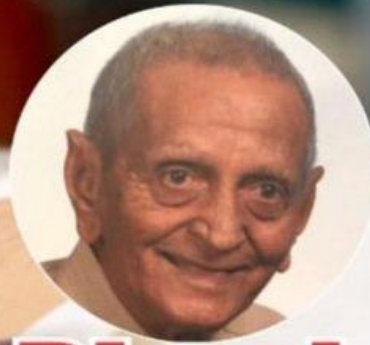
