AIM: To create awareness to donate blood amongst local population especially in the rural areas and motivate people to donate blood and after collection donate to Blood Banks in Chikhli, Valsad, Billimora, and Navsari.

DESCRIPTION: Blood donation camps are reduced after Covid-19 Pandemic. Blood stocks in the Blood Banks have drastically reduced due to lesser donors willing to donate blood hence we intend to acquire a vehicle fully equipped with all the modern facilities and equipment to get blood from the donors right inside the vehicle and bring awareness amongst people and motivate them to donate blood on regular basis.

Rotary Club of Chikhli River had organised Blood Donation Camps at various places in association with Blood Banks of Chikhli, Billimora, Valsad and Navsari.

The blood samples which we collect in the vehicle will be taken Free of Cost from the donors and shall be donated to these blood banks which will be Free of Cost.
