

Team Acropolis celebrates Teacher's Day with sheer novelty

Like earlier years, members of team Acropolis celebrated this Teacher Day in a special way. Members celebrated the day at the premises of Swami Vivekananda Shiksha Niketan, Bhagabatipur, South 24 Pgnas. Our DG Rtn Ajay Kumar Law obliged us with his graceful presence along with his spouse Rtn Mitali Law.

The program of celebration had, in its list, four projects, back to back, two of them involving long term civil construction (since complete). It commenced with the inauguration of "Refurbishment of classrooms" under club's signature project 'Sow a Dream Save a Smile', in which two dilapidated classrooms are transformed into modern classrooms. Our DG inaugurated the long cherished project of all members amidst cheers of all present.

Followed by this, the teachers of the school and other schools of the locality, 30 in numbers, were felicitated. Twelve senior teachers received cash of Rs.12000/- each and others were felicitated with clothes. This project is a recognition of team Acropolis to nation builders.

Inauguration of constructed toilet block for the school's girl students was the next project, which was inaugurated by Rtn Mitali Law. A small session was conducted to sensitize the girl students about health care and practice of hygiene.

The fourth project, namely "Installation of Sanitary Napkin Vending machine and Incinerator" under our club's tagline project 'Sampurna' was inaugurated jointly by Rtn Mitali Law and Rtn Debi Ghosh, Public Image Chair of Acropolis.

All these projects are undertaken through the contributions from Club members, their friends and relatives and financial support from NICCO PARK & Resorts Ltd. (Rs.1.50 lac) and BCPL Railway Infrastructure (Rs.1.00 lac) respectively (in the form of CSR) and a grant by EIRWT (Rs.1.00 lac). Total cost of all four projects is to the tune of Rs.6.50 lac.
