PROJECT – 1 (PROJECT OF CLASSROOM INAUGURATION)

- ✓ On 05.09.2021, Team Acropolis visited Bhubanchandra Uchcha Prathomik Bidyalay Jalaberia to inaugurate the reconstruction of the dilapidated classroom.
- ✓ This project was completed under our signature project of 'Sow a Dream and Save a Smile' the rural school infrastructure development initiative.
- ✓ In this project our club reconstructed one class room in a state of the art theme, with graffiti, ample amount of lights and fans provided them with high benches and low benches for hundred students to sit.
- ✓ A newly constructed modern toilet block, separately for boys and girls.
- ✓ This project was executed by our proposed RCC members and partly financed by Eastern India Rotary Welfare Trust.
- ✓ Hundred students and nine teachers will be benefited from this project.
- ✓ Total cost of the Project is Rs.4.15 lakh approximately.

PROJECT-2 (FELICITATION OF TEACHERS)

- ✓ On the same day, being "Teacher's Day" we celebrated by felicitating 12 school teachers from the same village. We handed over flower and dress material and treated all of them with sumptuous lunch.
