






8th November Project Annapurna : Yet another RCV ONE'S super duper project This month's donation by : Rtn. Dr. Nitin Bhate

Spots Covered : Canal Road, TP 13, behind Keya Motors, opposite Samsara Flats.



A forest being developed jointly by RC Vadodara ONE, Gujarat Forest Department and Gangadiya Village Gram Panchayat, at the hands of DG Santoshji & Sunetraji and Conservator of Forest Rajyaguruji. Under the leadership of Project Chair Sunil Joshi & Range Officer Kinjalben and with help of RCC and Gangadiya Gram Panchayat, an area of 3.5 acres around the crematorium was leveled for plantation and the fence installed too. 1200 of 1400 trees planted already based on species suggested by Dr Jitendra Gawli- Director Community Science Centre. A unique lay-out based on NavGraha is designed by Rtn Mitesh Punjani of Consortium D2E. This is just the beginning. The Rotary World : Congratulations Rtn.Dr.Benjamin List a Noble Prize Awardee

Rtn.Benjamin List is a German chemist who is one of the directors of the Max Planck Institutefor Coal Research and Professor of Organic Chemistry at the University of Cologne. He co-developed organocatalysis, a method of accelerating chemical reactions and making them more efficient. He shared the 2021 Nobel Prize in Chemistry with David MacMillan "for the development of asymmetric organocatalysis".



This year's Nobel Prize in Chemistry has been awarded to a Rotarian.Benjamin List, a member of the Rotary Club Mülheim a. d. Ruhr-Schloß Broich, and the Scottish-born U.S. researcher David W.C. MacMillan received this year's prestigious award. Both have developed methods for accelerating chemical reactions.
