Daniela-Mariana Sezonov Tane

“After falling in love with India, through the ancient wisdom of the Vedas and the Upanishads, I decided to study Hindi Language and Literature at the University of Bucharest. I was part of the first batch of students studying Hindi in post-communist Romania. In 1992 I received a scholarship from the Indian government, for the study of Hindi language and culture, at Kendriya Hindi Sansthan, Agra and this is how I discovered India at 22.

While in India, I discovered the beauty and hardships of the humanitarian work, and I decided to do some „seva” (in pure Indian tradition) for my other human fellows in distress and need. So, from 2005 to 2011, and later between 2014-2015, I left the comfortable life of a diplomat to work in field missions, for the International Committee of the Red Cross.

Now, the circle is closed and, after 17 years of peregrinations and learning, I am back to Mother India. I am glad and proud to work towards an enhanced cooperation and partnership between our countries and peoples. The mission of our Embassy is to promote closer cooperation with our partners in India, Nepal and Bangladesh in the political, economic, cultural, scientific, environmental, tourism and educational fields. We are also glad to be here for our Romanian citizens, coming here for pleasure, for work or family reasons, as well as for the Indian, Nepali and Bangladeshi citizens, willing to travel, to do business, to study or to cooperate with Romania.”
