This is the 2nd part of September 2022 Club Bulletin. The first part was devoted to the 11 Mammography Camps we held in the month of

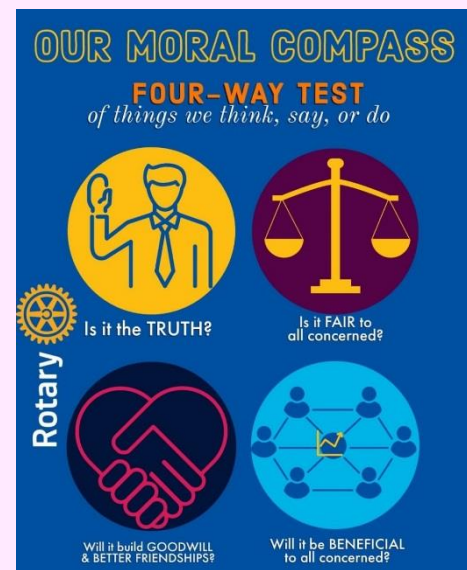
September 2022 and our Mission Possible – Breast Cancer Detection and Awareness Campaign.

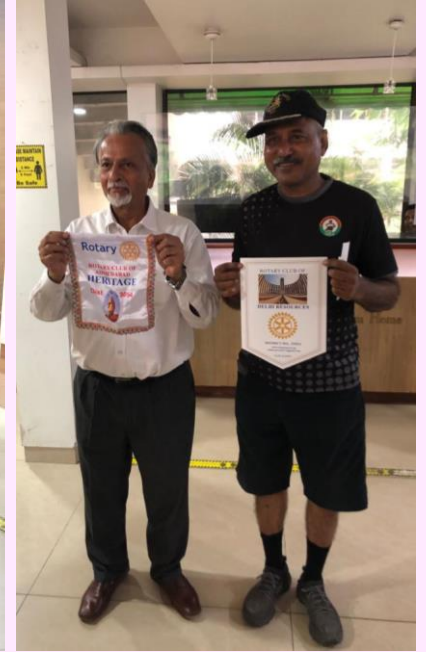

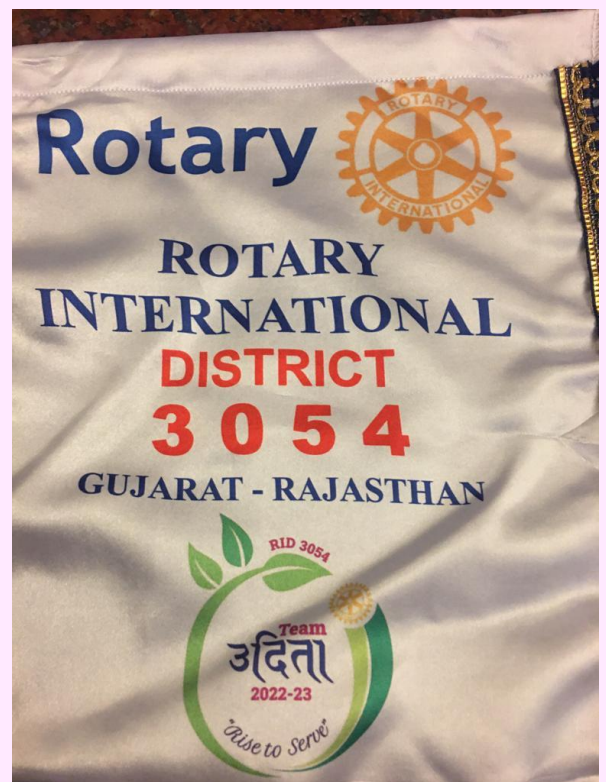
Meetings in September 2022

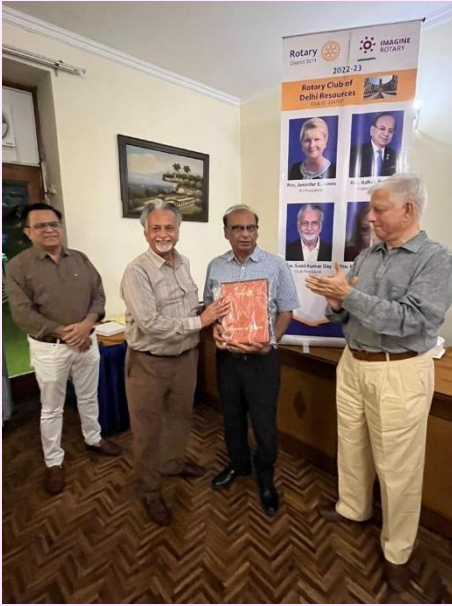
Board Meeting #1 was held on 09.09.2022 at Delhi Gymkhana Club

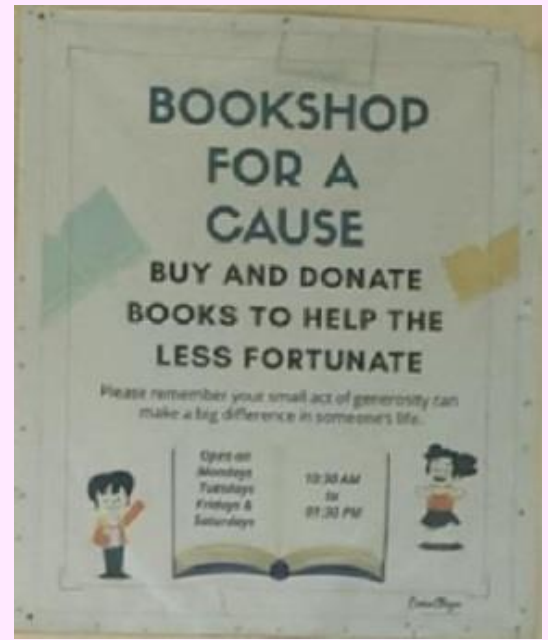

Art appreciation is: Gaining the knowledge to understand the art.

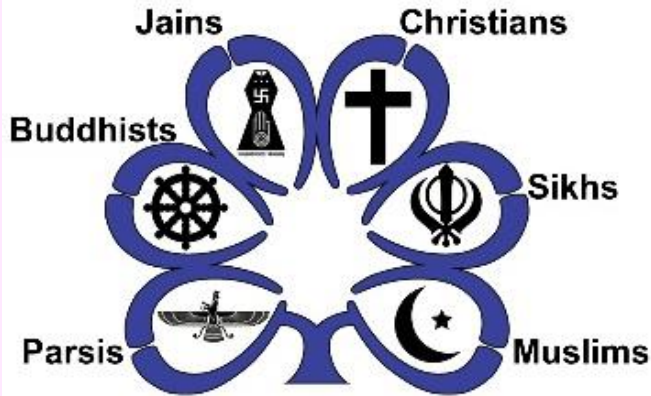

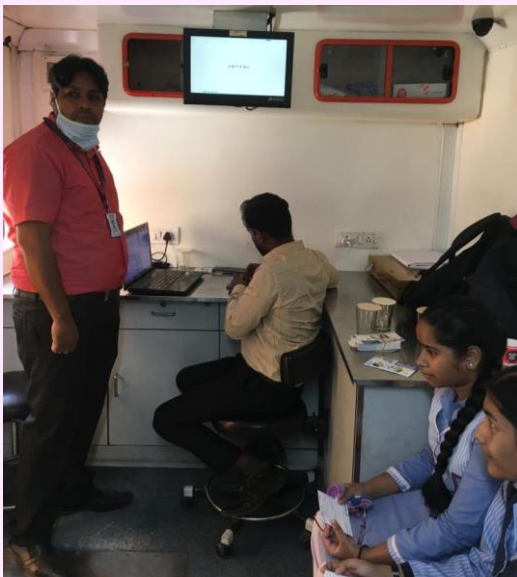


