

This is the 2<sup>nd</sup> part of September 2022 Club Bulletin. The first part was devoted to the 11 Mammography Camps we held in the month of


September 2022 and our Mission Possible – Breast Cancer Detection and Awareness Campaign.







Gifting 8 Class Room Tables to Delhi Nagar Nigam Pratibha Vidyalaya, ND on 8th Sept. 2022













Free General Health Check-up Camp at Rosewood Apartments, Vasant Kunj, ND on 10th Sept. 2022












