1988: Stage I: Skepticism

As a budding software engineer, I developed a software for a local Rotary Club in Mumbai and happened to attend one of the Rotary Conferences. I honestly did not carry a very good impression about Rotary or Rotarians for that matter, and I believed it was quite an "elitist" idea, one for the highly moneyed sections of society. This had no real basis except a superficial impression in 2 days where I was more concerned about the sales pitch for my own software, so on hindsight, it was not a very correct impression.

1990: Stage II: Maybe I am wrong

My paternal uncle became a District Governor in Pune and while accompanying him, I met a few Rotarians who impressed me. They seemed very down to earth and ran successful businesses. They were very good listeners and solution oriented people, as I observed the proceedings of a discussion on a Rotary project. One of them even offered me a job, and I was impressed by the trust Rotarians placed in each other and their families.. It also helped me realise that as an organisation , it is perhaps more socially oriented than I thought.

2013 : Stage III : Professional Association , and a kind of forced membership!

Years later when I was a corporate trainer, my good friends PPUdayraj Patwardhan and PP Vivek Jaykhedkar requested me to conduct the Rotary Youth Leadership Awards. As I trained over 50 young children on leadership, I met happy and engaged Rotarians who volunteered and supported me throughout the training session. I felt like I made a difference to the youth, and most importantly, it was a deeply satisfying activity. It also enlarged my circle of social contacts immensely as I met a diverse cross section of people from varying strata of society. I found myself getting persuaded to join the club, or rather I would look on it as an almost forced membership, as I could not refuse a good friend! So I thought, "Let me try this out".

2014 : Stage IV : Dissociated and non involved membership : I paid the fees and went through the recommended process to become a Rotary Club member, but I never really took the pains to attend a meeting and and out what is happening within a club. Bored, I was on the verge of quitting, 2015 onwards : Stage V : Engagement with the Club activities & Committed Rotarian : Luckily, my mentors PP Anil Sukenkar and Rtn. Madhavitai Sukenkar along with PP Vivek Jaykhedkar and PP Udayraj Patwardhan metaphorically held my hand and helped me get involved in the club activities that interested me. As I took the pains to get involved, there was no looking back . I realise now, that it was all up to me. People were around to help and facilitate, but my decision to give it a genuine try was what made my journey the most enjoyable . I can happily say that as a Rotarian, I believe I have been able to make a difference in the lives of thousands of people, including youth. Working my way up the various positions to lead the club as President in 2020-21, has been one of my most satisfying and fulfilling journeys so far. I have witnessed small ideas transform in to big life saving and life altering sustainable projects, experienced wonderful fellowships and have forged deep friendships!

Paying my Rotary dues made me a Rotary Club member, however, getting involved in a club activity was the turning point that contributed to me being a committed Rotarian.

I am sure every story is different. However, the key ingredient is the same : getting involved. It is not a function of time (we always make time for what we enjoy) nor money (service given is considered priceless). It is a matter of truly taking the effort and associating with the worlwide organisation and becoming a part of 1.2 million family of members.

As a Past President of the club, I appeal to all members to reach out to the Club President and anyone in the BOD or any friend in the club to know more about our dynamic, vibrant club and its various activities. To all the proposers, I would request that you work closely to see that the new and existing members truly enjoy their membership in every way. Please do not hesitate to volunteer for any role in any activity : Rotary is nothing if not voluntary service.

HISTORY OF ROTARY CLUB OF NASIK

Rotary club of Nasik was sponsored by Rotary club of Bombay. Late Rao Bahadur A. G. Gokhale organised the first meeting of the club on 20-12-1944. The first President of club was Sardar N.G. Vinchurkar, Charter Secretary was Rao Bahadur A.G. Gokhale, Charter members were 21. Charter was granted on 23-3-1945. (Charter No. 5935). Club celebrated its silver jubilee in the year 1969-70. In the silver jubilee year President was Isaq-Rangwala, Secretary was Dr. M.D.Rajpathak and membership was 44. Club celebrated its golden jubilee in 1994-95, Club - President was Rtn. Dr. Rohit Shah, Secretary was Rtn. Vivek Athawale and membership was 88. This year our club is celebrating Platinum Jubilee 2019-20, Club President Adv Manish Chindhade, Secretary Dr Mrs Shreeya Kulkarni with membership 172. Initial meetings of the club were held at Santosh garage. Thereafter meetings were held at Red Cross Hall, Sarvajanik Vachanalaya, I.M.A. Hall. Club acquired its own land from Nashik Muncipal Corporation in year 1981-82 by active efforts of Rtn. Khushal Poddar and Datta Nathe, Dr. V. P. Gupte and Administrator Talreja. Rotary charitable trust of Rotary Club of Nasik was formed in year 1983-84, charter trustees being Dr. Appa Pawar, Bachubhai Joshi and P.G. Mehta and R.K. Gupta. Aim of the trust was to properly develop Rotary hall and Community hall and to take care of assets of Rotary Club of Nasik. From 1985 onwards meetings were held at basement hall of Rotary hall

Rotarynama

Our bulletin named 'Rotarinama' obtained 1st Trophy for best bulletin during a tenure of PP Balasaheb Joshi as a President. Since then the, tradition of printing out good bulletins is maintained.

Major Notable Projects by RCN:

• Almost 50,000 family planning operations were done by Rtn. PDG. Dr. Appa Pawar & Dr. V. N. Pawar which is a record Laparoscopes were donated by Rtn.RK.Gupta to Rotary Club of Nasik.

• 1971-72 An Ambulance was donated to Indian Medical Association Nasik.

• 1975-76 Massive eye Camp-358 patients were operated at Ayurved Hospital.

• 1980-81 Massive diagnostic and surgery camp for physically handicapped was organised.

• 1982-83 Water Tank with a tap at Khatvad village.

• 1984-85 350 Adivasi group marriages provided a distinguished service award to R.C. of Nasik under the leadership of Dr V. N. Pawar.

• 1991- 92 10000 copies of Khumbmela Margadarshika booklets were printed and distributed to Yatries of Simhastha.

• 1994-95 President was Dr Rohit Shah. Golden Jubilee Year. Rotary Health Society founded to provide health awarness programme by organising lectures in regional languages. Rs 250001- were donated by PP Shantilal Lodha for this cause from Deepchand Fakirchand Loddha Trust. Physiotherapy centre started through donation of Rs. 1.25 lacs by a Panchavati Panjarapole Trust to take care of physically handicapped.

Nashik Bhooshan Awards

During 1996- 97, under the presidency of Vijay Kothari. Nasik Bhooshan Awards were instituted to recognise people who have contributed to uplift the image of Nasik in the Map of Maharashtra. Till date the awardees include Kusumagraj allies Tatyasaheb Shirwadkar, Vasant Kanetkar, Vasantrao Gupte, Vinayakdada Patil, Shantabai Dani, Dr. Vasant Pawar, Bapu Nadkarni, Babubhai Rathi, Kusumtai Patvardhan, Balasaheb Datar, Sudhakar Bhalerao, Benjan Desai, Dr. Narendra Jadhav, Uttam Kamble, Vijay Kakatkar, Devendra Bapat, Rajendra Bagve, Amol Chitnis, Vinayak Govilkar. Ar Sanjay Patil to name a few. In 1997-98, under the Presidential leadership of Ganesh Lad, a permanent vocational training centre started at Harsul in adiwasi Area.- from a donation from Mr. Patil of U.S.A. through Maharashtra Sanskrutik Mandal functioning at U.S.A.

Subsequent presidents implemented and executed a number of projects like Bal Sahitya Jatra Cataract Camps, Yoga Classes, RYLA Niramaya Nasik, a project for comprehensive development of Nasik City, Uniform distribution for Tribal students, water management projects- rain water harvesting projects, Dishavedh- counselling centre, Arthritis knee braces camps, Rural library, Rotary Gram Sanivani- Rural Development project, RFE visit to Pakistan, Membership reached all time high figure of 104, Matching Grant Project for toilets in villages like Manur and Nave Nirpur, donations of Benches, Solar Equipments and water coolers to schools in Tribal area.

Service Partners:

Club has various partners in service such as Innerwheel Club, Rotaract Club, Interact Club, Rotary Community Corps, Senior Citizens Club etc. All these are actively organising their own projects. The interact movement received a great boost and now number stands at more than 50 clubs.

Club completed several matching grant and global grant projects such as Borewell with a storage tank at village Talegaon (Dindori), provision of Nutritive food at Ashramshala at village Ambe of Taluka Surgana, happy schools, equipment at neonatal ICCU at Nelson hospital and cardiac cath-lab at Magnum Hospital etc.

Club has sponsored students for IYE and members for GSE programmes.

Donation for TRF/ Foundation Giving

As of now, a total of 136 Paul Harris fellows (\$1000 donations) and 29 major donors (\$10000 donations) and 7 Benefactors are there in the club, with an all time giving by club of \$426283. Club has won recognition at district level and RI level on several occasions. Club got 11 trophies for outstanding work done in all 4 avenues of Rotary service in year 1994-95 a golden jubilee year of the club. PDG Dr Appasaheb Pawar, PDG Balasaheb Joshi and PP Dr, Ramesh Karkare have also been awarded Service Above Self Award.

Till date, the club has med its presence felt in the society and has a number of service projects to its credit. During the last few years, the club reached phenomenal heights under the dynamic and visionary leadership of various Presidents. A record number of Community Service projects including clean hands and cut nails, bench distribution and bunk bed distribution, cataract surgeries were completed successfully and a mammoth turnover of funds was handled efficiently. Microcredit Projects in collaboration with Magasaysay Awardee Smt Neelima Mishra was another highlight of the year. During 2013-14, E-Bulletin was started. Anti tobacco campaign was launched in schools. Public Awareness programme for detection of breast cancer was commendable.

Some of the recent permanent projects include check dams at Shivshet near Peth, school class rooms construction and renovation at Ganeshgaon, hostel buildings for boys and girls at Igatpuri, skin bank and mortuary box at Vedant Hospital. These projects have been funded by various CSR initiatives of corporates.

The membership reached a record high of 217 members in 2016-17. The club enjoys excellent fellowship and family events full of entertainment, quality time.

The club has a constitution and a leadership development plan in place. Club president and secretary are selected posts and are groomed for 3-4 years before assuming the position. Rest of the board is elected through an unbiased open election process, overseen by an election committee.

Nasik Rotary Charitable Trust

Record of Nasik was chartered in year 1945. After some years, members felt the need to have a space of its own to conduct meetings etc. It was felt that a trust needs to be created to collect required funds and also take care of day to day looking after the property that was planned to be constructed on the land allotted by Nasik Municipal Corporation.

This paved the way for formation of Nasik Rotary Charitable Trust on 29 June 81. Funds were raised by organising a charity show of the dance troupe of legendary Hema Malini. Some more fund were donated by the club members. This enabled construction of Rotary Hall.

Formation of NRCT helped members in getting requisite IT exemption for the donations made. Being directed donations, these funds are then used by the club for undertaking projects to serve society.

Every year audited accounts are submitted to Charity Commissioner office. Also evey year list of trustees is also submitted to Charity Commissioner.

With changing times, NRCT has complied with all the legal requirements to receive funds by companies under their CSR obligation. With this, RCN is garnering more and more funds every year to be utilised for socially required and relevant projects in line with areas of focus of Rotary. In the Rotary year 21-22, we received almost 1 Crores of funds under CSR.

Board of trustees headed by Chief Trustee oversee the functioning of the trust. Current President and Secretary of the RCN are ex officio members of the trust. Besides past presidents only are eligible to become trustees. There are always odd number of trustees like 7,9,11 etc.

TRF (The Rotary Foundation) Activities by RCN

The Rotary Foundation helps fund our humanitarian activities, from local service projects to global initiatives. Our Rotary Club Nasik has been involved in the TRF activities by way of giving and participating in Matching grant or Global grants since beginning. Since last 76 years our club has contributed more than 500000 USD amount to foundation and involved in doing good for society in the form of Grants valuing 619973 USD.

Foundation recognition is an essential part of each Rotary club. Our 7 club members have donated 10000 USD to become Major Donors while 5 members have committed to donate to Foundation 1000 USD every Rotary Year and become Paul Harris Society Members! Our Club has more than 70 Club members who has been recognised as Paul Harris Fellows and more than 130 non-Rotary members contributed to Foundation. We are proud Club who donates every year to foundation.

We are happy to give brief of various projects done by our Club under Foundation Grants.

RY-2006-2007-Construction of Toilet Blocks in Manur & Nirpur Village Project Value: 15000 US\$

Project beneficiaries- 500 Nos

RY-2017-2018- Nashik Teach Program- By implementing TEACH program in schools, we shall try to provide basic facilities such as in schools right from Teacher's Training, E-Learning facility, Adult Literacy, for overall child and school development to create Happy Schools.

Project Value: 39,298 US\$

Achievements:

- 1. Teachers Training This was TRAIN THE TRINER workshop. There were 86 attendees, they were direct beneficiaries of the training, who were trained for improving teachers' skills
- a. for better student-teacher relationship,
- b. for understanding child psychology
- c. Overall resulting in enhancing learning outcome of the students.
- 2. E-Learning kit distribution Total 33 E-learning kits were installed in 25 schools, each of them comprising of about 11300 students. These E-learning kits helped students to understanding concepts with assistance of Audio, visual, animated form of syllabus. E-Learning improved their understanding of the concepts clearly, which improved their interest in academic subject.
- 3. Child Development 3216 books of General Knowledge, Literature, History and Geography were given to 24 schools, as a part of library updating, with beneficiary students approximately 10000.
- 4. Café kit Distribution Excellent quality of Café kits of were distributed to 1150 students of Zilla Parishad (Local Government Body) 23 schools, in tribal area around Nashik in tribal villages of Igatpuri Taluka. The deprived students of the society, who were under privileged, unable to buy basic things were given these full school café kits.
- 5. Adult Literacy About 900 Books were purchased from Rotary International for Adult literacy (RILM). Students of class 8th, 9th and 10th were asked to educate illiterate adults in their community with the help of these books. Rotract Clubs were also involved in taking adult literacy camps in the villages. Taking Adult literacy camps and use of these books by students in villages, is ongoing project. Till now 410 books out of these 900 books have been distributed, and nearly 470+ adults have been benefited.

RY-2020-2021- Neonatal and Paediatric Intensive Care Centre- To provide best quality Neonatal and paediatric intensive care to children of lower socioeconomic strata at an affordable cost The cost of intensive care in children is high mainly because of the cost of equipment. The objective of this project is to bring down the cost of treatment of critically in children from low socio-economic strata.
