Club Assembly Reports

SERVICE PROJECTS

FOOD BANK

Project Food Bank is running in full swing and has reached large number of people in and around Kolkata.

- On **4th July**, cheese nachos & Sofit soya milk were distributed to children at our new vocational centre at Tangra. President Ashok Agarwal and First Lady Usha were present.
- On **8th July**, we have distributed 300 ration kits at Sunderbans. Each kit is of 8.1 kg which includes rice, atta, dal, oil, haldi and salt. These kits were given to widows of either COVID affected person or to the families affected by the attack of tigers.
- On **9th July**, chips packet were distributed to the children of local lorry driver at Kashipur area by Rtn. Dharampal Ajitsaria.
- On **15th July**, milkshakes & coffee was distributed at Kalighat area to more than 250 under-privileged people. Khichdi and Samosa was sponsored by Rtn. Sanjay and KavitaBhalotia.
- On **16th July**, Bhawna Shah & Yukta Shah distributed to 160 plus families different food items like puffed Rice, Milk Shakes, Tang energy drinks etc. These beneficiaries livelihood is sustained as Farmers, Vendors of fruits and vegetables, Road and building daily wage workers, JCB and Tractor drivers, Gardeners etc.
- On **18th July**, distribution was done to 600+ people at Southern Avenue.
- On **23rd July**, Ration kits were distributed at Arya Vidya Mandir School.
- On **24th July**, the villagers of Khejurtalla and Charagram and Hedwa village in North 24 Parganas got Kellogs, Oreo Biscuits and Hershey's Milk shake to around 1000 people. This was arranged by Club Secretary Payal Agarwal.
- On **25th July**, an excellent project at Hingalganj approximately 100 KM from Calcutta and was attended by 10 Rotarians and spouses. We donated 100 Ration kits, 6 Cartons of Oreo biscuits and 4 cartons of chips to 150+ local needy People of the area.
- On **26th July**, 20 Nutri Kits, 55 packets of cocoa, 110 Hershey milkshakes and 110 Oreo biscuits were distributed at NavJeevan, a home run for destitute children. This was arranged by Spouse AnuVidhawan
- On **27th July**, RtnShyam Modi arranged distribution of ITC beaten coffee and mad angle chips to the villagers of Raghunathpur
- On **1st August**, Mahanagar have distributed Oreo Biscuits, Tetra pack of Milk Shake & Koki Krunch from Nestle to 1100 Girls of Arya Parishad Vidyalaya For Girls, Khidderpore, Port Area.
- On **3rd August**, Nutri kits were distributed at a bustee in CIT road. Thanks to AnuVidhawan for the initiative.
- On **21st August**, Rtn. Sanjay Bhalotia and KavitaBhalotia, distributed chips, Hershey's milkshakes, and Hershey's chocolates, to 150 children, at Kandagaon, Newtown.
- On **16th August**, we distributed nutri kits worth Rs. 3 lacs to workers in AmtaJoka.
- On **27th of August**, Oreo Biscuits under our Food Bank Project worth 1 lac, were distributed to different organisations, NGOs, Old Age Homes, Streets of Kolkata & so on. We thank Rtn. Raj Somani, Rtn. Dharampal for their help in this service.
- On the **29th of August**, Oreo Biscuits were distributed under our Project Food Bank to 600 + beneficiaries, at Vivekananda Park.
- On the **30th of August**, we distributed Oreo Biscuits among 800 + beneficiaries, under our Food Bank Project, at the Bhawanipore Sitla Mandir, S. N. Pandit Street, Kolkata.
- On **5th September**, on behalf of RCC Mahanagar, Bhawna Shah and Yukta Shahdistributed "Food hampers" comprising Choco bakes, Choco Bricks, 5 Stars, Chips, Oreo chocolate biscuits and Yippee Pasta, to 233 families, in eco-friendly paper bags. 25-30 Bournvita packs were distributed selectively among the beneficiaries, who had 2 children and /or elderly parents at home. The beneficiaries included daily labours, van cart pullers, gardeners, masons, house maids, garbage cleaners, vegetable vendors, fruit sellers, painting labours, water body cleaners, peons, security etc.
- On the **5th of September**, members of RCCM went approximately 50 km away from the city, to bring a smile on the faces of the, village children by distributing different food items from our Food Bank to more than 500 + beneficiaries, at the Ramrampur Village, Indra Polly, Diamond Harbour Road, organised by our member, RtnShyam Modi.
- On **12th September**, Food was distributed at Patherghata, New Town arranged by Rtn. Sanjay Bhalotia. More than 500 beneficiaries were there.
- On **17th September**, Yukta Shah distributed Cadbury Choco Bakes and 5 star chocolates to daily wage earners. Similarly food materials were also distributed to the people near our Eye Hospital.

PROJECT MENSTRUAL HYGIENE MANAGEMENT (MHM)

Aiming on Women empowerment, an area of focus of our RI President Shekhar Mehta, Project MHM named **RED PRIDE** was launched on 1st July. We had an awareness programme with 40+ girls/women at our vocational centre at Tangra.

At Tiljala alsowe had an awareness camp where we also distributed them Menstrual Hygiene Kitcontaining reusable sanitary napkins. AnuVidhawan also spoke about Nutrition to them.

- On **21st August**, we had an awareness programme, with 50 girls and women, aged 25-40 years, at Knowledge Prabhat School, Belguria Express. We also distributed among them, some menstrual hygiene kits, containing reusable sanitary napkins and also raised awareness about Nutrition among them.
- On the **28th of August**, 50 beneficiaries participated in our Project Menstrual Hygiene Management at Tiljala. Our gratitude to spouse Reena Bhandari, for sponsoring Dupattas for the beneficiaries.
- On the **4th of September**, 50 beneficiaries participated at Tiljalawhere we distributed among them Menstrual Hyginekits containing reusable sanitary napkins, along with accessories and Cake & Biscuits from our Food Bank
- On **11th September**, 50 girls participated in another camp organised at Tiljala. Kits were distributed to them.

Till now over 300 girls have been benefitted by our Project MHM. We thank our Sponsor **PP Rtn. Chitra Agarwal, Rtn. Usha Agarwal, Sunita Singhal, Neelam Singhvi and Veera Jain** for supporting this projects wholeheartedly.

HOMEOPATHY CLINIC

Our Homeopathy Clinic at Bhowanipore reopened on 3rd July after the recent lockdown situation. It is now running in full swing. **We thank Rtn. Ashok Singhvi for sponsoring the Homeopathy Clinic.** The Clinic is open twice a week.

In July around 110 patients were checked and given free medicines.

EYE CLINIC

Our Eye Clinic in Bhowanipore is open regularly and patients are treated with utmost care keeping all COVID protocols in mind. Every week patients are checked and given free spectacles. We Thank PP. Rtn. Vinod Mahipal for sponsoring the Eye Clinic.

- Around 12 Cataract Surgeries were done on **4th August** at our Netralaya. Patients were from Old Age Home, Little Sister of the poor, AJC Bose Road, Kolkata.
- On **12th August**, 15 cataract surgeries were done and on 20th August, 5 cataract surgeries were done at our Netralaya
- On **29th of August**, 44 surgeries were conducted under the new GG 2120241 at our Eye Hospital.
- On **4th of September**, 5 free surgeries were done in our eye hospital.
- On **6th September**, at our Eye Hospital 16 cataract surgeries were conducted.
- On **14th September**, 19 eye surgeries were done under the new Global Grant.
- On **18th September**, 5 cataract surgeries were done.

MAHANAGAR BLOODLINE

- Our Mahanagar Bloodline is working round the clock even in this pandemic situation. From **28th July to 4th August**, we met the need of blood of two people.
- Our Club carried out a Blood Grouping Camp on **8th August**, and registered 21 SOS donors for our Bloodline. Camp was conducted at R KChaterjee Road, Sabij Sangha, Kolkata. We also met the need for 2 patients.
- Our Club carried out a Blood Grouping Camp on **15th August**, and registered 37 SOS donors for our Bloodline. Camp was conducted at Diamond Harbour Road, Kolkata. We also met the need for 2 patients.

- Another Bloodline Camp was conducted on **22nd August**, Sunday at "Jannagar Ariyan Boy's Sporting Club", Jannagar Road, Kolkata, where 36 SOS Donors were registered. We also met the needs of 4 Patients.
- Blood Grouping Camp was conducted at "Netaji Subhash Engineering College" Techno City, Gariaon the **29th of August, 2021**. 36 SOS Donors were registered and the need of 1 patient was met.
- On **10th September**, Blood camp was organised at Maniktola Fire Station Rec. Club

COVID RELIEF

All of us are making an effort to ease the wrath of COVID by any manner possible. Taking a small step towards this, Rotary Calcutta Mahanagar, on 9th July, has given Five Oxygen concentrator & 25 jumbo cylinders to Military Hospital at Panagarh. It will be used to treat COVID patients. Thanks to the organization ACT & SWASTH , for tieing up with us and providing the Oxygen equipment.

Similarly, on 12th July, we have supplied 10 oxygen concentrator & 50 jumbo cylinders yet again to Panagarh Military Hospital. They are setting up this hospital to deal with the possible third wave. We are helping them in this respect.

We have also given Five Oxygen concentrator to Park Clinic, near Minto Park, Kolkata.

We have been felicitated by Eastern Command for this gesture.


