Manoranjan Tripathi I.G. (Retd), was born in Mussoorie on 26th July, 1953.

He did his schooling from Wynberg Allen School and went on to do his Post Graduation from M.P.G. College, Mussoorie. He represented Meerut University in Football.

He joined B.S.F. in 1975 where he held various staff, field and instructional assignments, which included a member of the Organizing Committee of IX Asian Games in New Delhi in 1982. He commanded a battalion in counter insurgency operations in Kashmir & Mizoram. He commanded the BSF intelligence setup in Kashmir. He was part of the B.S.F. contingent for a Peace keeping mission to Democratic Republic of Congo.

During the course of his service, he earned The Kathin Sewa Padak, Gallantry Medal, President's Police Medal for Meritorious

Service and President's Police Medal for Distinguished Service, apart from many other recognitions.

He retired as an Inspector General from B.S.F. in 2013 and is serving Rotary Mussoorie since 2015.



♦ Scholarship Chairman—PAG Shaillendra Karanwal

Maybe to a lesser number of students. •Will give scholarships to the students who stood 1st and 2nd from class 6th onwards. • Vocational Scholarship amount will be Rs.15000. • Rs.21000 will be awarded to the topper of Mussoorie.

◆ Literacy & Teach—Chairman—PP Shalabh Garg The Chairman proposes to organize an Adult Literacy Programme by educating the Rickshaw pullers & coolies and others by giving them basic education which is

♦ Water Management—Chairman—PP D K Jain

The committee proposes to identify 1 or 2 villages who are facing water scarcity because of the distance of the source from their village. Rotary may lay pipe lines to make their life easier.

♦ Curative Health & Medical Aid—Chairman—PAG Vipul Mittal

Chairman assures that medical assistance will be provided to the genuine and needy people of the community as the need arises.

♦ Civil Rights & Consumer Awareness—Chairman— PDG Ranbir Singh

Chairman proposes to invite heads of various public departments in Rotary Meetings, to discuss the problems of the town, and find ways and means to find short term and long term solutions for same.

♦ CSR & Fund Raising—Chairman—Rtn Sandeep Sahni

Our Chairman is confident that funds will not be of any hurdle to execute any project and sincere efforts will be made as per the requirement. The funds will be arranged as the project at hand demands from the house, district and then the society at large.

♦ Rotary Medical Center—Chairman—Rtn Sandeep Sahni

The club has already acquired the land and the basic structure for the Centre has been completed.

♦Neki ki Dewar—Chairman—Rtn Rajat Agarwal

Our Chairman proposes that the Neki Ki Deewar will be open for the public throughout the day from 9.00 A.M To 9.00 P.M and the attendant will be present every day for one hour to manage the upkeep of the cupboard. The cloth received from the donor will be sorted out, washed and pressed and will be placed by the attendant in the respective racks in the cupboard.

Sanitation & Wins-Chairman-Rtn Ashwani Mittal

The committee under the chairmanship of Rtn. Ashwani Mittal proposed to install drinking water and hand wash booth counter at Govt School, Camels back road. The chairman also wants to put posters in all the schools to educate the students regarding safe drinking water, proper sanitation and personal hygiene.

♦ Preventive Health—Chairman—PP D K Jain

Eye and dental checkup camps will be organized for the students and staff in two to three Hindi Medium schools. Besides this, the chairman proposes to arrange a talk on general health and hygiene. An additional emphasis will be given on how to keep proper immunity and natural ways to keep the body healthy.

The Committee also proposes to arrange a full body pathology testing including ECG and Mammography. It would be exclusively only for the Rotary Families.

♦ Disaster Management—Chairman—PP Sharad Gupta

The committee proposes to provide relief, rehabilitation and other voluntary services to those affected by natural calamities. Our President Manoranjan Tripathi ji has proposed a talk by a member of NDMA (National Disaster Management Authority) in the month of July or August. The chairman also proposes to organize a lecture cum demonstration by a team of SDRF Uttarakhand in the month of September or October on disaster management. This type of program has been done previously also by our club in various schools.
